QUARTERLY REPORT – 31 December 2013

PART A: NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

A1. BASIS OF PREPARATION

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the reporting requirements of *MFRS 134 Interim Financial Reporting* issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The accounting policies and methods of computation adopted for the interim financial statements are consistent with those adopted for the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2012.

The explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 31 December 2012 and should be read in conjunction with the Company's audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2012.

A2. AUDITORS' REPORT ON PRECEDING YEAR'S FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The report of the auditors to members of the Company dated 24 April 2013 on the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2012 did not contain any qualification or any adverse comment made under Section 174(3) of the Companies Act, 1965.

A3. SEASONALITY OF OPERATIONS

The Group's results were not materially affected by any major seasonal or cyclical factors.

A4. UNUSUAL ITEMS AFFECTING ASSETS, LIABILITIES, EQUITY, NET INCOME OR CASH FLOW

Premier Gesture Sdn Bhd ("PGSB"), a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company, had on 31 December 2013 entered into a shareholders' agreement with Almaharta Sdn Bhd ("ASB") to set out the terms governing their relationship as shareholders in a joint venture company, Premier De Muara Sdn Bhd ("PDMSB") in connection with the proposed development of a piece of leasehold land located at Wilayah Persekutuan KL held under title PN 45266 Lot 141 Seksyen 88, Bandar Kuala Lumpur, Daerah Kuala Lumpur, Negeri Wilayah Persekutuan ("Development Land"). The entire issued and paid-up capital in PDMSB was held by PGSB as at 31 December 2013.

QUARTERLY REPORT – 31 December 2013

PDMSB, as developer, had also on the same date entered into a joint venture agreement ("JVA") with ASB, as registered and beneficial owner of the Development Land, in relation to the proposed development of the Development Land.

In conjunction with the above, a refundable sum of RM10,000,000 was paid by PDMSB to ASB upon execution of the JVA subject to the fulfilment of the conditions precedent contained in the JVA.

Further information on the above can be obtained from the Company's announcement dated 31 December 2013.

There were no other unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows for the current quarter and financial year-to-date under review.

A5. CHANGES IN ACCOUNTING ESTIMATES

There were no changes in accounting estimates that have had a material effect in the current quarter and financial year-to-date results.

A6. DEBT AND EQUITY SECURITIES

There were no issuance, cancellation, repurchase, resale and repayment of debt and equity securities for the current quarter and financial year-to-date under review.

A7. DIVIDENDS

There were no dividends being declared during the current quarter and financial year-to-date under review in relation to the financial year ended 31 December 2013.

A final dividend for the financial year ended 31 December 2012 was approved by the shareholders at the Company's Twelfth Annual General Meeting held on 27 June 2013 and was paid on 23 July 2013.

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A10. EVENTS AFTER BALANCE SHEET DATE

There were no material events of a material and unusual nature subsequent to the end of the financial period under review that are likely to affect substantially the results of the operations of the Group for the financial period.

On 29 January 2014, the Company announced its proposal to undertake a renounceable rights issue of up to 54,445,440 Rights Shares at an issue price of RM0.55 per share, on the basis of three (3) Rights Shares for every five (5) existing shares of the Company held together with up to 54,445,440 Warrants on the basis of one (1) Warrant for every one (1) Rights Share subscribed for, on an entitlement date to be determined later.

Further information on the rights issue can be obtained from the Company's announcement dated 29 January 2014.

A11. CHANGES IN COMPOSITION OF THE GROUP

On 31 October 2013, Premier De Muara Sdn Bhd ("PDMSB"), a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Group was incorporated under the Companies Act, 1965 as a private company limited by shares. The authorised capital of PDMSB is RM5,000,000 divided into 5,000,000 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each of which fifty one (51) ordinary shares have been issued to the wholly owned subsidiary, Premier Gesture Sdn Bhd ("PGSB"), and are fully paid up.

On 1 November 2013, PGSB acquired two (2) ordinary shares of RM1.00 each in Valencia Glade Sdn Bhd ("VGSB") representing the entire issued and paid-up capital in VGSB for a total cash consideration of RM2.00. VGSB was incorporated in Malaysia on 9 September 2013 with an authorised capital of RM400,000 divided into 400,000 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each, of which two (2) ordinary shares of RM1.00 each have been issued and are fully paid-up.

There were no other changes in the composition of the Group during the current quarter and financial year-to-date under review.

A12. CONTINGENT ASSETS

The Group does not have any contingent assets as at the end of the quarter under review.

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A13. CONTINGENT LIABILITIES

As at the end of the quarter under review, the Company has provided corporate guarantees amounting to RM50.0 million to financial institutions for facilities granted to its subsidiaries.

Apart from the above, the Group does not have any other contingent liabilities as at the end of the quarter under review.

A14. CAPITAL COMMITMENTS

There were no capital commitments outstanding not provided for in the financial statements as at the end of the quarter under review.

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PART B: ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THE LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD

B1. ANALYSIS OF PERFORMANCE

The Group's revenue of RM20.9 million for the fourth quarter of 2013 was RM1.9 million higher than the RM19.0 million reported in the corresponding quarter of the previous year. Revenue for the financial year under review was RM78.8 million, RM5.7 million lower than the RM84.5 million recorded in the preceding year.

The revenue of RM14.2 million from the webbings, yarn and furniture components segment for the current quarter was similar to the revenue recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2012. The segment's revenue for the financial year of RM57.0 million was however RM7.2 million lower than the RM64.2 million recorded last year as the economies in the Group's key export markets in the US and Europe continue to be slow.

The rubber strips and fabrics segment recorded revenue of RM6.2 million during the quarter under review, an increase of RM1.5 million compared to the RM4.7 million recorded in the corresponding quarter of the previous year as sales of rubber fabrics continue to improve. The segment's revenue for the financial year of RM21.2 million was also RM1.0 million higher than the RM20.2 million recorded last year.

Despite the higher revenue, the Group's profit before tax of RM1.1 million for the fourth quarter of 2013 was RM0.7 million lower than the RM1.8 million recorded in corresponding quarter of the previous year. This is mainly due to the impairment of RM0.7 million of goodwill arising on consolidation of a subsidiary during the quarter.

Although revenue for the financial year under review was RM5.7 million lower than the RM84.5 million recorded in the preceding year, profit before taxation of RM5.9 million was RM0.6 million higher than the RM5.3 million reported for 2012. This is mainly due to the improved performance of the rubber strips and fabrics segment as well as the stronger US Dollar against the Ringgit which resulted in net foreign exchange gains.

Profit before tax recorded by the webbings, yarn and furniture components segment during the quarter under review was RM1.0 million, RM1.1 million lower than the RM2.1 million reported for the corresponding quarter of last year. The segment's profit before taxation of RM5.3 million for the financial year was also RM1.5 million lower than the RM6.8 million recorded for last year. Apart from registering lower revenue, the soft global economy has also prompted competitors to reduce prices in order to sustain market shares. This has resulted in the Group having to reduce margins to remain competitive and

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maintain its market position. The impact is slightly lessened by the favourable US Dollar-Ringgit exchange rates which resulted in higher net foreign exchange gains.

The rubber strips and fabrics segment reported a profit before tax of RM0.7 million for the quarter under review compared to a loss of RM0.2 million recorded in the corresponding quarter of the previous year. The segment also recorded a profit before tax of RM0.9 million for the financial year against the loss of RM1.1 million recorded during the previous financial year. The relatively stable rubber prices and the improving rubber fabrics sales contributed to the encouraging performance of the segment.

B2. VARIATION OF RESULTS AGAINST PRECEDING QUARTER

The Group's revenue of RM20.9 million for the current quarter was RM1.3 million higher than the RM19.6 million reported for the third quarter of 2013 as the turnover from the rubber strips and fabrics segment improved.

The Group's profit before tax for the current quarter of RM1.1 million was however RM0.8 million lower than the RM1.9 million recorded in the previous quarter mainly due to the impairment of RM0.7 million of goodwill arising on consolidation of a subsidiary.

B3. PROSPECTS

The economies of the Group's major export markets in the US and Europe are expected to continue their slow growth and will impact the Group's performance for 2014. While the recovery to the US economy is forecasted to gather pace from the middle of 2014, the Eurozone is still expected to remain sluggish with only modest growth being predicted for 2014.

The Group will strive to protect its market position by staying focused behind our core business strategies and at the same time actively seek opportunities for growth. Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Group's performance for 2014 is expected to be satisfactory.

We should also be mindful that any significant movement in the exchange rate between the Ringgit and the US Dollar will result in foreign exchange gains or losses which will affect the Group's results as the Group derives a substantial amount of its revenue in US Dollars.
