3. RESTRUCTURING AND LISTING EXERCISE

In conjunction with, and as an integral part of the Listing, the Company implemented a restructuring exercise which was approved by the FIC on 6 March 2003, the MITI on 18 March 2003, and the SC on 7 August 2003 and 16 October 2003 which involved the following inter-conditional transactions:

3.1 Share Split

The share split involved a change in the par value of CAB's ordinary shares from RM1.00 each to RM0.50 each, by way of sub-division of the par value for every existing ordinary share in CAB.

Upon completion of the share split, the issued and paid-up share capital of CAB increased from RM2 comprising 2 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each to RM2 comprising 4 CAB Shares. The share split was completed on 7 August 2003.

3.2 Acquisition of CABC

On 28 January 2003, CAB entered into a conditional share sale agreement with the shareholders of CABC to acquire the entire issued and paid-up share capital of CABC comprising 5,500,000 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each (inclusive of 3,500,000 new ordinary shares of RM1.00 each in CABC to be issued pursuant to a rights issue by CABC) for a total purchase consideration of RM29,940,143 to be satisfied wholly by the issuance of 48,143,546 new CAB Shares, at approximately RM0.6219 per CAB Share.

The purchase consideration of RM29,940,143 was arrived at based on a willing buyer-willing seller basis after taking into consideration the audited NTA of the CABC Group as at 30 September 2002 of approximately RM19.81 million, the revaluation surplus (net of deferred tax) of its land and building of approximately RM13.83 million and the future proposed dividend payments and the proposed rights issue by CABC as stated below. The adjusted NTA of the CABC Group is approximately RM37.14 million.

Prior to the Acquisition of CABC, on 15 July 2003, the Directors of CABC declared a special dividend of RM1.75 per existing ordinary share of RM1.00 each held in CABC based on the issued and paid-up share capital of 2,000,000 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each held in CABC. On 31 July 2003, CABC implemented a rights issue of 3,500,000 new ordinary shares of RM1.00 each in CABC on the basis of 7 new ordinary shares of RM1.00 each in CABC for every 4 existing ordinary shares of RM1.00 each held in CABC.

The Acquisition of CABC was completed on 8 August 2003.

 - (c) 2,228,000 Public Issue Shares to the identified investors by way of private placement; and
 - (d) 6,000,000 Public Issue Shares available for application by the Malaysian public.
