A. EXPLANATORY NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORT - FRS 134

A1. Basis of Preparation

This interim financial statement has been prepared under the historical cost convention except for the revaluation of landed properties.

This interim financial statement is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") 134 - "Interim Financial Reporting" and Paragraph 9.22 of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("BMSB") and should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 31 December 2007.

A2. Changes in Accounting Policies

The accounting policies and methods of computation adopted by the Group in this interim financial report are consistent with those adopted in the annual financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2007 except for the adoption of the following new/revised Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") effective for financial period beginning 1 January 2008.

Revised FRS 112 - Income Taxes

(a) Revised FRS 112: Income Taxes

FRS 112 addresses the accounting treatment for income taxes. However, FRS 112 does not prescribe the accounting treatment for reinvestment allowance and investment tax allowance (tax incentives). In the current accounting policy for income taxes, reinvestment allowance or investment tax allowance is treated as the tax base of an asset. On adoption of FRS 112, the Group accounts for the tax incentives as a reduction in tax rate applied to deferred tax liabilities in FRS 112. The Group achieved revenue of RM71.8 million for the quarter ended 30 June 2008 as compared to RM49.3 million in the corresponding quarter of the preceding year, an increase of RM22.5 million or 46%. The increase in revenue was mainly due to RM 12.5 million sales arises from the trading segment, and RM10.0 million or 20% growth recorded from the existing compounding and retreading segment.

The Group reported profit after tax of RM0.5 million as compared to RM1.3 million in the corresponding quarter of the preceding year. The result in Q2 2008 was affected by profit margin erosion due to significant increase in material costs and weakening US Dollar compared to the last financial year.

The Group's revenue in current financial quarter increased 17% from RM 61.2 million in Q1 2008 to RM 71.8 million. The growth was mainly from the trading segment which increased RM3.7 million or 42% and RM6.9 million or 13% growth from existing compounding and retreading compared to the last quarter.

Overall, the group achieved a net profit of RM0.5 million for the current financial quarter.

- i) On 5 September 2007, Goodway (HK) Pte Limited, a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company entered into a Joint Venture Agreement with World Bond (H.K.) Limited, Lu Xiao Fei and Guan Huai Yun for the establishment and management of a new joint venture company. The company is to undertake the investment in the business of the manufacturing and sales of rubber tyres and recycled rubber tyres, production of precured tread liner in the People's Republic of China, excluding Hong Kong, the Macau Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China and Taiwan. On 15 August 2008, the Joint Venture Agreement had been terminated by mutual consent due to the non-performance of the obligations by all parties.
- ii) On 8 October 2007, the Company entered into a Joint Venture Agreement with Shenzhen Xinxihu Holdings Co Ltd for the establishment and management of a new joint venture company which will be principally involved in manufacturing and trading of retread tyres in the People's Republic of China. The joint venture company was successfully incorporated on 23 July 2008.
- iii) Further to the Company's announcement made on 4 July 2008 in relation to non-compliance with the requirement of the public shareholding spread as required by Para 8.15(1) of the LR, Bursa Malaysia has vide their letter dated 16 July 2008 approved the Company's application for a further extension of time of six (6) months until 14 January 2009 in order to comply with the public shareholding spread requirement. As at 30 June 2008, the public shareholding spread of the Company according to the Record of Depositors was 41.55% and there were 928 public shareholders holding not less than 100 shares.
