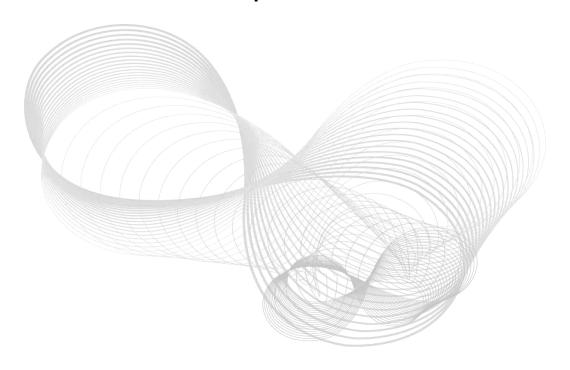

A. EXPLANATORY NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORT - FRS 134

A1. Basis of Preparation

This interim financial statement has been prepared under the historical cost convention except for the revaluation of landed properties.

This interim financial statement is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") 134 - "Interim Financial Reporting" and Paragraph 9.22 of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("BMSB") and should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the Financial year ended 31 December 2008.

A2. Changes in Accounting Policies

The accounting policies and methods of computation adopted by the Group in this interim financial report are consistent with those adopted in the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2008.

A3. Audit Report of Preceding Annual Financial Statements

The audit report of the Group's Financial Statements for the year ended 31 December 2008 was not subject to any qualifications.

A4. Seasonality or Cyclical

The Group's operations are not materially affected by seasonality or cyclical factors during the quarter under review.

A12. Changes in the Composition of the Group

There were no changes in the composition of the Group for the current quarter under review save and except for the following: -

- i) On 20 August 2009, the Company had acquired the entire equity interest of 1,000,000 ordinary shares of Hong Kong Dollar One (HKD1.00) only each in the share capital of Goodway Simplex (HK) Pte. Limited from its wholly-owned subsidiary, namely Goodway (HK) Pte. Limited ("GHK") for a total consideration of HKD600,000.00 only. Subsequent to the acquisition, GSHK will be wholly-owned by GIIB.
- ii) On 10 September 2009, the Company had submitted an application to strike-out its dormant subsidiary, namely Ever Lord Tyres Sdn Bhd pursuant to Section 308 of the Companies Act, 1965 to the Companies Commission of Malaysia.
- iii) On 3 November 2009, the Company had submitted an application of deregistration of its wholly-owned subsidiary, namely Goodway (HK) Pte. Limited pursuant to Section 291AA of the Company Ordinance, Hong Kong to the Registrar of Companies in Hong Kong.

The Group posted revenue of RM53.6 million during the quarter under review as compared to RM80.9 million in the same quarter of last year, a decrease of RM27 million. This was mainly due to lower sales volume.

Nevertheless, the Group had reported a profit after tax of RM1.14 million as compared to loss after tax of RM0.8 million in the same quarter of last year as a result of better cost control.

During the quarter under review, the Group gained a higher revenue of RM53.6 million, an increase of 17% from RM45.8 million in the previous quarter. Further, the Group remained profitable despite a lower profit after tax of RM1.14 million as compared to RM1.76 million reported in the previous quarter because of the continuous rise in the global commodities prices since June.

B3. Prospects

The overall performance from all business segments are as expected with better improvement in revenue generated by the retreading segment. Generally, the Group's financial position remained strong despite lower profit margin during the quarter under review. It is foreseeable that the raw material prices is likely to continue to increase until year end, which may be challenging to the Group in terms of passing the cost to the customers on time. Nevertheless, the Management of the Group is cognisant that continuous efforts in improving the operational efficiency will contribute to a stable outlook in the next quarter.

The group has not issued any profit forecast or profit guarantee during the current quarter under review.

The effective tax rate of the Group for the current quarter was higher than the statutory tax rate as certain expenses were not deductible for tax purposes and certain subsidiaries' operational losses, which are not available for Group tax relief.

Forward foreign exchange contracts

The Group uses foreign exchange forward contracts to hedge its exposure to foreign exchange risk arising from operational, financing and investment activities.

Foreign exchange forward contracts are used to reduce the risk exposure to fluctuations in foreign exchange rates. However, this is subject to the risk of market rate changing subsequent to acquisition, such changes are generally offset by opposite effects on the items being hedged.

Foreign exchange Forward contracts used for hedging purposes are accounted for on an equivalent basis on the underlying assets, liabilities or net positions. Any profit or loss arising is recognised on the same basis as of the related assets, liabilities or net positions.

Foreign exchange forward contracts that do not qualify for hedge accounting are accounted for as trading instruments and marked to market at balance sheet date. Any profit or loss is recognised in the in come statement.

The maturity dates for the forward foreign exchange contracts entered into range from 1 to 3 months.
