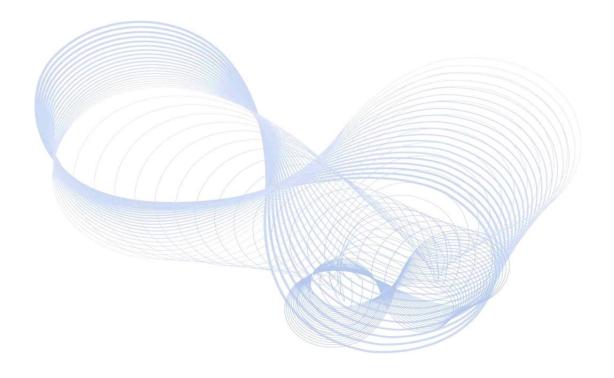

A. EXPLANATORY NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORT - FRS 134

A1. Basis of Preparation

This interim financial statement has been prepared under the historical cost convention except for the revaluation of landed properties.

This interim financial statement is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") 134 - " Interim Financial Reporting" and Paragraph 9.22 of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("BMSB") and should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the Financial year ended 31 December 2008.

A2. Changes in Accounting Policies

The accounting policies and methods of computation adopted by the Group in this interim financial report are consistent with those adopted in the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2008.

The Group registered a higher revenue of RM57.7 million during the quarter under review, an increase of 45% from RM39.7 million recorded in the same quarter of last year. On a year to year basis, the Group's revenue dropped by 22.9% resulted to a lower revenue of RM195.4 million in year 2009 as compared to RM253.5 million in year 2008. However, the Group's bottom line has improved significantly as shown in its profit after tax of RM4.48 million in year 2009 against its loss after tax of RM12.8 million posted in year 2008.

The positive turnaround was largely due to the improved income generated from its two main businesses of rubber compound manufacturing and provision of tyre retreading services. Besides that, the Group's consistent efforts in improving its cash flow management, cost/expense management as well as inventory management has further strengthened its financial position in year 2009.

The Group's revenue during the quarter under review stood at RM57.7 million, an improvement by RM4.1 million or 8% from RM53.6 million as recorded in the previous quarter whereas its profit after tax reduced to RM682,000 as compared to RM1.14 million posted in the previous quarter due to deferred tax and impairment of fixed assets amounting to RM2.6 million.

B3. Prospects

Generally, the local retreading industry's outlook remain positive whilst gaining stronger acceptance in emerging markets such as China and Indonesia despite the slow recovery of the global economic downturn in year 2008. This is in line with the Group's on-going plan in Indonesia via a joint venture partnership in setting up a a company to carry out the sales and distribution network of rubber compound materials and pre cured tread liners as well as the relocation of its existing production facilities in Suzhou to Nantong, China. Moving forward, the Management of the Group is in view that the Group's outlook in year 2010 will continue to prosper.

The Group uses foreign exchange forward contracts to hedge its exposure to foreign exchange risk arising from operational, financing and investment activities.

Foreign exchange forward contracts are used to reduce the risk exposure to fluctuations in foreign exchange rates. However, this is subject to the risk of market rate changing subsequent to acquisition, such changes are generally offset by opposite effects on the items being hedged.

Foreign exchange Forward contracts used for hedging purposes are accounted for on an equivalent basis on the underlying assets, liabilities or net positions. Any profit or loss arising is recognised on the same basis as of the related assets, liabilities or net positions.

Foreign exchange forward contracts that do not qualify for hedge accounting are accounted for as trading instruments and marked to market at balance sheet date. Any profit or loss is recognised in the in come statement.

The maturity dates for the forward foreign exchange contracts entered into range from 1 to 3 months.
