For the three months ended 30 June 2014, total revenues decreased by 27.7% to RM50.9 million from RM70.4 million while PBT registered a decrease of 53.9% to RM1.5 million from RM3.2 million respectively compared to the preceding year's quarter ended 30 June 2013. The decrease in sales revenue for the quarter under review compared to the preceding year's quarter was mainly attributed to lower sales by both the Compounding and Retreading Businesses.

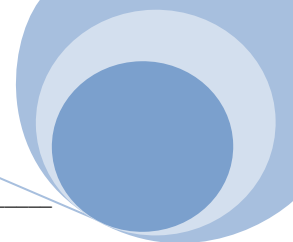
Current quarter registered a lower profit before tax of RM1.8 million as compared to RM3.2 million a year ago due to lower market demand.

Revenue decreased by 12.5% from RM58.2 million reported in the immediate preceding quarter to RM50.9 million in the quarter under review as a result of lower sales reported for both the Compounding Business and the Retreading Business.

The current quarter registered a Profit before tax of RM1,5 million, as compared to a Profit before tax of RM0.6 million posted in the preceding quarter due to improved cost minimisation effort.

The Board is constantly working towards achieving a satisfactory Group performance in the current year as the demand for the Group's rubber compounding and retreading business segments are expected to improve.

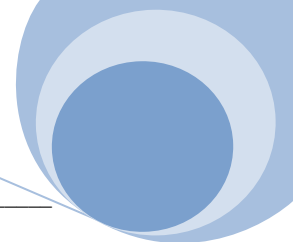

Forward foreign exchange contracts are recognised on the contract dates and are measured at fair values with changes in fair values being recognised as profit or loss.

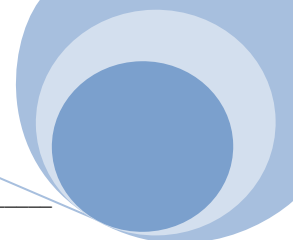
