B1 Review of Performance

Group revenue reduced by 55.7% or RM18.2 million as compared to preceding year's quarter mainly due to the fire incident on 9 July to 13 July, which has also affected the output for this quarter. In addition, the current turmoil in the international market has caused the Group to be more careful in selecting customers and thus affecting its overall turnover to a certain extent.

The Group registered a loss of RM9.3 million as compared to RM23.3 million on year on year basis. This represents a decrease of appproximately RM14.0 million or 60%. The improvement is mainly due to lesser assets write off in current year as compared to previous year. In addition, the tight control system implemented by the Group has to a certain effect able to improve its operating efficiency.

B2 Comparison with immediate preceding quarter's results

Group revenue increased compared to the preceding quarter by 20.2% or RM2.4 million mainly due to increased production as the Group is able to recover its production facility to a certain extent from the fire incident as reported in previous quarter.

On the back of an increased turnover, the Group is able to register a smaller loss of RM2.0 million as compared to RM11.2 million. In addition, the improved performance is also partly due to the need to make a loss provision of RM8.7 million is last quarter as a result of the expected loss arising from the fire incident. The Group did not provide any provision this quarter as based on its estimation, the current estimation is sufficient.

The Group continues to operate in a challenging environment due to uncertainty in the global economy.
