#### Corporate information

Progressive Impact Corporation Berhad ("the Company") is a public limited liability company incorporated and domiciled in Malaysia, and is listed on Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements were approved by the Board of Directors on 24 November 2014.

### **Environmental consulting & engineering**

For the third quarter ended 30 September 2014, Environmental consulting & engineering segment contributed 47% from the total Group's revenue. Revenue decreased by 21% or RM7.6 million during the period ended as compared to the preceding year corresponding period ended 30 September 2013. The decrease were mainly due to the decrease in the foreign operation's revenue as compared to the preceding year corresponding period ended 30 September 2013.

#### Laboratory testing

Laboratory testing segment contributed 44% of the total Group's revenue. The segment shows an increase by 15% as compared to the previous year corresponding period ended 30 September 2013 mainly contributed by the increase of sales from the operation in Malaysia and Indonesia.

### Waste management engineering

Waste management engineering segment recorded a revenue of RM3.1 million during the period ended 30 September 2014 as compared to RM6.3 million in the preceding year corresponding period ended 30 September 2013. The decrease due to lesser projects in hand for the segment in the current quarter.

### Consolidated profit before tax

For the third quarter ended 30 September 2014, the Group's profit before tax (PBT) was RM6.87 million which is 5% lower as compared to the preceding year corresponding period ended 30 September 2013 of RM7.26 million. Decreased was due to reduction of revenues and increase of depreciation and other operating expenses in the Indonesia operation.
