## Notes on the quarterly report – 31 December 2008

### PART A: EXPLANATORY NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORT

#### A1. Basis of preparation

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Financial Reporting Standards (FRS)134 (Interim Financial Reporting) and Paragraph 9.22 and Part A of Appendix 9B of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities").

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 31 December 2007. The explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group.

The accounting policies, method of computation and basis of consolidation adopted for this quarterly financial report is consistent with those adopted for the Group's audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2007.

## **A2.** Qualification of Annual Financial Statements

There were no audit qualifications on the annual financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2007.

## A3. Seasonal and cyclical factors

The Group's business operation results were not materially affected by any major seasonal or cyclical factors.

# A4. Unusual nature and amounts of items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows

There were no unusual nature and amounts of items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows during the current quarter under review.

## **A5.** Material changes in estimates

There were no material changes in estimates of amounts reported in the current quarter under review.

### A6. Issuances and repayment of debt and equity securities

There were no issuance, cancellations, repurchase, resale and repayment of debt and equity securities for the current quarter under review.

### A7. Dividend Paid

There was no dividend paid by the company during the quarter under review.

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### A8. Segment information

The Group's operations are categorized as fibre-based products. These can be further categorized into sub-groups of disposable fibre-based products such as disposable baby diapers, sanitary napkin, cotton products, serviettes and box tissue. Another sub-group would be processed paper which includes printing paper, color paper, newsprint and corrugated carton boxes. As the products are all fibre-based and the Group only operates in Malaysia, no segmental reporting is prepared.

## A9. Valuation of property, plant and equipment

The property, plant and equipment except for freehold land are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation. No depreciation is provided on freehold land. There was no revaluation of property, plant and equipment for the current guarter and financial year to date.

### A10. Material events subsequent to the end of the interim period

There were no material events subsequent to the end of the current quarter.

### A11. Changes in the composition of the Group

There were no changes in the composition of the Group during the current quarter under review.

### A12. Changes in contingent liabilities

As at the date of announcement, there were no material contingent liabilities incurred by the Group which, upon becoming enforceable, may have material impact on the financial position of the Group.

### A13. Capital commitments

There were no significant capital commitments as at 31 December 2008.

# A14. Comparison with preceding quarter's results

The preceding year's quarterly profit is higher than the current quarter due to the Group receiving RM6.5million in insurance compensation, captured as other operating income. Revenue for the year improved by RM37.5 million from the previous year as a result of the increased revenue from the disposable fibre-based segment.

In line with increased activities from the disposable fibre-based segment, operating expenses and finance costs also saw increases as compared to the previous year. Profit before tax for the 12 months ended 31 December 2008 is RM2.6 million lower than 2007 mainly due to the insurance income received in 2007.

## **B1.** Review of performance

The Group achieved a revenue of RM238.4 million and profit before tax of RM10.1 million for the 12 months period to date.

# **B2.** Variation of results against preceding quarter

In the preceding corresponding quarter ended 31 December 2007, the Group achieved a revenue of RM59..7 million and profit before tax of RM7.4 million as compared to the current quarter revenue of RM55.0 million and profit before tax of RM1.9 million.

The decrease in profit before tax is due to insurance income received in 2007 as disclosed in A14.

### **B3.** Next financial year prospects

The economic outlook for 2009 is currently not encouraging. The economic growth rate of the world and Malaysia have seen downward revisions as economists continue to digest new economic data. The Group has adopted its business strategy to face uncertain times by reducing inventory holding and cut down on levels of borrowing. Increasing efficiency and monitoring market situations will continue to play important roles to allow the Group's financial position to remain strong. Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Group thus views 2009 cautiously, focusing its efforts to increase efficiency and maintain healthy cashflows.

# **B4.** Variance of actual and forecast profit

The Group has not provided any quarterly profit forecast and therefore no variance information is available for presentation.
