14. Review of earnings and/or revenue of the Company and its subsidiaries for current quarter and financial period-to-date

During the quarter under review, the Group achieved revenue of RM27.0million, representing a decrease of RM9.9 million (from RM36.9million to RM27.0million) or 27% as compared to the corresponding quarter preceding year. The decrease in revenue was largely attributed to the lower sales generated from steel product and trading activity segment during current quarter under review.

The Group's revenue for the current financial period-to-date decreased by RM25.3 million (from RM104.8 million to RM79.5 million) or 24% as compared to corresponding financial period-to-date in prior year. The decrease in the Group's revenue was mainly due to lower sales recorded in steel product and trading activity segment this financial period.

The Group's profit before tax ("PBT") of RM10.3 million in the financial period-to-date was RM3.0 million or 41% higher as compared to the corresponding period prior year. The revenue generated from machinery and equipment segment increased by 30% over previous financial period. This growth has contributed to the higher PBT achieved during current financial period.

There were no material factors affecting the earnings and/ or revenue of the Group for the current period under review.
