NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORT

SECTION A DISCLOSURE NOTES AS REQUIRED UNDER FRS 134

1 Basis of preparation

The Interim Financial Report has been prepared under the historical cost convention except for the revaluation of freehold land included within property, plant and equipment. Investment property is stated at fair value.

The Interim Financial Report is Unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with the requirement of FRS 134: Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities").

The Interim Financial Report should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended May 31, 2006 The explanatory notes attached to the Interim Financial Report provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended May 31, 2006.

2 Changes in accounting policies

The significant accounting policies adopted are consistent with those of the audited financial statements for the year ended May 31, 2006 except for the adoption of the following new/revised Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") effective for financial period beginning June 1, 2006:-

The adoption of FRS 108, 110, 116, 127, 128, 132 and 133 does not have significant financial impact on the Group. The principal effects of the changes in accounting policies resulting from the adoption of the other new/revised FRSs are discussed below:-

(a) FRS 3 : Business Combinations, FRS 136 : Impairment of Assets and FRS 138 : Intangible Assets

The new FRS 3 has resulted in consequential amendments to two other accounting standards, FRS 136 and FRS 138.

The adoption of these new FRSs has resulted in the Group ceasing annual goodwill amortization. Goodwill is carried at cost less accumulated impairment losses and is now tested for impairment annually or more frequently if events or changes in circumstances indicate that it might be impaired. Any impairment loss is recognized in profit or loss and subsequent reversal is not allowed. Prior to June 1, 2006, goodwill was amortised on a straight-line basis over its estimated useful life of 20 years. This change in accounting policy has been accounted for prospectively for business combinations where the agreement date is on or after June 1, 2006. The transitional provisions of FRS 3, however, have required the Group to eliminate at June 1, 2006, the carrying amount of the accumulated amortization of RM2,050,057 against the carrying amount of goodwill. The carrying amount of goodwill as at June 1, 2006 of RM728,472 ceased to be amortised. This has the effect of reducing amortization charges by RM25,700 in the current quarter and in the financial period ended August 31, 2006 respectively. Other intangible assets of the Group with finite useful lives continue to be stated at cost less accumulated amortization and impairment losses.

Under FRS 3, any excess of the Group's interest in the net fair value of acquirees' identifiable assets, liabilities and condition liabilities over cost of acquisitions (previously referred to as "negative goodwill"), after reassessment, is now recognized immediately in profit or loss.

(b) FRS 101: Presentation of Financial Statements

The adoption of the revised FRS 101 has affected the presentation of minority interest, share of net after-tax results of associates and other disclosure. In the Condensed Consolidated Balance Sheet, minority interests are now presented within total equity. In the Condensed Consolidate Income Statement, minority interests are presented as an allocation of the total profit or loss for the period. A similar requirement is also applicable to the Condensed Consolidate Statement of Changes in Equity. FRS 101 also requires disclosure, on the face of the Condensed Consolidated Statement of Changes in Equity, total recognized income and expense for the period, showing separately the amounts attributable to equity holders of the parent and to minority interest.

The current period's presentation of the Group's financial statements is based on the revised requirements of FRS 101, with the comparatives restated to conform with the current period's presentation.

(c) FRS 140: Investment Property

The adoption of this new FRS has resulted in a change of accounting policy for investment properties. Investment properties are now stated at fair value, representing open-market value determined by external valuers. Gain or losses arising from changes in the fair values of investment properties are recognized in profit or loss in the period in which they arise. Prior to June 1, 2006, investment properties were stated at valuation. Revaluations were carried out at least once every five years and any revaluation increase is taken to equity as a revaluation surplus. In accordance with the transitional provisions of FRS 140, this change in accounting policy is applied prospectively and the comparatives as at May 31, 2006 are not restated. Instead, the changes have been accounted for by restating the following opening balances in the Condensed Consolidated Balance Sheet as at June 1, 2006:-

15 Performance review

During the first quarter for financial year 2007, the Group recorded an operating profit before depreciation and finance cost of RM0.13 million (FY2006, RM0.05 million) on the back of a total revenue of RM11.87 million (FY2006, RM13.70 million). The Group's revenue decreased by 13.4% for the quarter under review as compared with the preceding year corresponding quarter. However, as a result of lower operating expenses and staff cost, the operating profit margin increased marginally from 9.07% to 9.67% an increase of 6.7%.

As a result of the reduction in the Group total borrowings from RM24.59 million in the preceding year corresponding quarter to RM18.42 million, the finance cost had decreased by 18.4% from RM0.47 million to RM0.38 million.

However, the Group recorded a loss before taxation amounted to RM0.22 million (FY2006, a loss of RM0.40 million) and overall net loss attributable to the equity holders of the parent was RM0.39 million as compared to a net loss of RM0.47 million recorded in the preceding year corresponding quarter.

The Group's gross revenue increased by 16.6% from RM10.18 million recorded in the immediate preceding quarter to RM11.9 million in the current quarter under review. The increase in revenue was mainly contributed to the increase in demand of logistics business of a few major customers and new customers.

The increase in operating profit margin from 8.9% to 9.7% resulted in an increase in operating profit before impairment loss and depreciation by 3.6%. The reduction in other operating cost and staff cost by 39.7% and 2.9% respectively also affect the increase in operating profit.

In the preceding immediate quarter, the Group has reversed an impairment loss amounted to RM0.21 million. Excluding the gain in the reversal of the impairment loss, the loss before taxation and the net loss attributable to the equity holders of the parent reduced by 36.2% and 9.2% respectively.

17 Commentary on prospects

The Group, as one of the major land transporter is facing a difficult and challenging period in view of the escalating operating cost such as fuel and tyres.

Despite the downside risk, the Group is continuing with the on going cost reduction programme and de-gearing exercise to transform itself into a leaner and efficient organization to seek a higher representation in the domestic market for the financial year.

29 Listing requirement of the minimum paid-up capital

As stipulated under the Securities Commission's Policies and Guidelines on Issue/Offer of Securities and the Bursa Securities Listing Requirements, the minimum issued and paid-up capital of a company listed on the Second Board of Bursa Securities shall be RM40.00 million.

On June 30, 2004, the Company was categorized as an undercapitalized company as its paid-up share capital is RM29.00 million.

On May 11, 2005, Bursa Securities approved the Company's application for extension of time until September 30, 2006 to comply with Paragraph 8.16A of the Listing Requirements.

On September 28, 2006, the Company has appealed to Bursa Securities for another extension until November 30, 2006 to comply with the Listing Requirements. As at the date of this report, Bursa Securities has yet to reply to the Company's appeal.

There is no further development on the status of the Company's plan.

The Directors are pursuing this matter to ensure compliance with the requirement.
