B ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THE BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD LISTING REQUIREMENTS

B1 Review of performance

For the current quarter ended 30 June 2011, the Group recorded a lower revenue of RM23.99 million as compared to RM27.26 million for the quarter ended 30 June 2010 due to slight decline in sales volume for black toner. Lower sales volume for black toner is mainly resulted from the increased prices to absorb the higher cost of production. The decrease in revenue was further compounded by the further strengthening of Malaysian Ringgit against US Dollar.

Profit before taxation for the Group decreased by 56.7% or RM3.22 million to RM2.46 million compared to RM5.68 million for the corresponding quarter ended 30 June 2010, mainly contributed by the decrease in revenue and increase in production cost arising from the installation of new lines and higher material costs. Malaysian Ringgit has surged approximately 8.35% against US Dollar as compared to the quarter ended 30 June 2010.

B2 Variation of results against preceding quarter

The Group recorded revenue of RM23.99 million for the current quarter under review against RM22.90 in the preceding quarter ended 31 March 2011, an increase of 4.76% or RM1.09 million. The increase was mainly due to higher sales volume of both black and colour toner attributed to the normalisation of sales, since the slow down in the world economy and natural disasters which occurred in the second half of year 2010 coupled with the natural disaster in Japan occurred in the previous quarter.

Profit before tax increased by 4.24% or RM0.1 million to RM2.46 million as compared to RM2.36 million in the preceding quarter ended 31 March 2011. Profit before tax improved due to higher productivity and lower operating expenses incurred for the quarter under review.

B3 Prospects

Amidst the highly uncertain global economies, particularly in the United States and Europe; rising material cost as a result of the Japanese earthquake/ tsunami in March; appreciation of Japanese Yen as well as the weakening of US Dollar against the Malaysian Ringgit, the Group remains cautious and will continuously manage risks to sustain its sales volume moving forward. The Group also aims to penetrate new market segments by developing more niche and high value products, and embark on a differentiation strategy to promote its environmentally-friendly Palmotone Colour Chemically Produced Toner.
