PART A - EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO MFRS 134

1. BASIS OF PREPARATION

The interim financial report is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") 134, Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial report should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 31 March 2012 which was prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS").

2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The quarterly condensed financial report is the Group's first MFRS condensed financial report for the part of the period covered by the Group's first MFRS framework annual financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2013, and hence, MFRS 1: First Time Adoption of Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards has been applied.

The significant accounting policies and methods of computation adopted for the interim financial report are consistent with those of the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 March 2012. The transition from FRS to MFRS did not have material impact on comprehensive income, financial position and cash flows of the Group.

The business of the Group was not affected materially by any seasonally or cyclical factors for the financial quarter under review.

7. DEBT AND EQUITY SECURITIES

During the financial year, the Company increased its issued and paid-up ordinary share capital from RM 19,170,495 to RM 86,053,165.90 by way of issuance of 668,826,709 ordinary shares of RM 0.10 each via a rights issue on the basis of seven rights shares for every two shares held on the entitlement date, and 26,312,306 additional warrants of the Company issued pursuant to the adjustments to the outstanding warrants in the Company as a consequence of the rights issue.

Bhd, a private limited company incorporated in Malaysia, with an authorized capital of RM 100,000 comprising 100,000 ordinary shares of RM 1.00 each, of which 2 ordinary shares of RM 1.00 each have been issued and fully paid up, for a cash consideration of RM 2.00. On 23 October 2012, PAE subscribed 39,998 ordinary shares of RM 1.00 each, for a cash consideration of RM 1,057 and other consideration of RM 38,941, out of its allotment of RM 49,998 ordinary shares of RM 1.00 each.

13. CHANGES IN CONTINGENT LIABILITIES AND CONTINGENT ASSETS

There were no material changes in contingent liabilities or contingent assets since the last statement of financial position as at 31 March 2012.

Extrusion and fabrication

Year to date turnover was RM 56.7 million compared to RM 59.6 million for the same period in the previous year, a drop of 5%. Operating profit however was RM 45,000 compared to RM 4.4 million previously. The drop was mainly due to higher overhead and competitive pricing as a result of intense competition.

Aluminium billet and tolling

This sector recorded a turnover of RM 1.6 million compared to RM 8.0 million in the previous year, a drop of 80%. Operating losses was RM 2.1 million compared to RM 1.9 million. As mentioned previously, this was due to drop in sales.

Construction contract

This sector recorded a turnover of RM 6.7 million compared to 7.4 million in the previous year, a drop of 9%. Losses however increased to RM 1.9 million compared to RM 0.2 million previously. The higher losses was mainly due to additional cost incurred during the completion of some contracts.

Renewable Energy

This new business recorded sales of RM 2.6 million and an operating profit of RM 0.5 million during the period under review. Increased efforts are being made to secure higher sales for this sector.

Others

This was mainly expenses incurred by the holding company and other subsidiaries which were dormant.

Extrusion and fabrication

Turnover for the quarter under review was RM 13.4 million compared to RM 24.5 million for the corresponding quarter in the preceding year, a drop of 45%. The lower turnover was due to major customers reducing its requirement during the year-end holidays. With the lower demand our products have to be priced competitively to maintain our market share. In line with the lower turnover, operating losses was RM 1.9 million compared to the profit of RM 1.6 million previously.

Aluminium billet and tolling

Turnover for the sector was RM 0.8 million compared to RM 2.6 million previously. The lower turnover was mainly due to the drop in sales.

Construction contract

Turnover for this sector was RM 0.2 million compared to RM 2.3 million previously. The turnover was relates mainly to the last stages of the contract billing. No new jobs were started during this period, hence the lower turnover. In line with the low turnover, this sector recorded losses of RM 1.7 million.

Renewable Energy

As mentioned previously this sector managed to secure sales of RM 2.6 million with profit of RM 0.5 million. More efforts will be put into this sector to secure higher sales.

17. COMING QUARTER PROSPECTS

Extrusion and fabrication

The group has invested substantially in this sector to be ready for growth in the future. New production lines are being installed and production processes are being constantly reevaluated and improved. More customers both local and foreign are being developed at the same time. It is hoped that all these efforts will result in a turnaround in this sector in the near future.

Aluminium billet and tolling

This sector is expected to perform in line with the higher demand in the extrusion and fabrication sector. Improvement in the extrusion business should also help this sector turnaround.

Construction contract

The bulk of the effort in this sector is geared towards securing more contracts. At the same time we are also increasing the sub contractors' pool and improving purchasing efficiency. The following months should be critical to the success of this sector.

Renewable Energy

Being a new venture by the group, increased sales will be major thrust in this sector. This sector should continue to perform well and contribute positively to the group.

18. PROFIT FORECAST OR PROFIT GUARANTEE

No profit forecast or profit guarantee has been issued by the Group.
