PART A - EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO MFRS 134

1. BASIS OF PREPARATION

The interim financial report is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") 134, Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial report should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 31 March 2013 which was prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS").

2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The quarterly condensed financial report is the Group's first MFRS condensed financial report for the part of the period covered by the Group's first MFRS framework annual financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2013, and hence, MFRS 1: First Time Adoption of Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards has been applied.

The significant accounting policies and methods of computation adopted for the interim financial report are consistent with those of the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 March 2013. The transition from FRS to MFRS did not have material impact on comprehensive income, financial position and cash flows of the Group.

12. CHANGES IN COMPOSITION OF THE GROUP

On 11 March 2013, the Group, P.A Resources Bhd (PAR) acquired 100% equity interest in Dominasi Reka Sdn. Bhd (DRSB), a private limited company incorporated in Malaysia, with an authorized capital of RM 100,000 comprising 100,000 ordinary shares of RM 1.00 each, of which 2 ordinary shares of RM 1.00 each have been issued and fully paid up, for a cash consideration of RM 2.00.

On 12 March 2013, the authorized capital of DRSB was increased from 100,000 to RM 5000,000 divided into 5,000,000 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each by the creation of RM 4,900,000 new ordinary shares of RM 1.00 each, PAR subscribed for 1,999,998 ordinary shares of RM 1.00 each, for a cash consideration of RM 1.00 each.

13. CHANGES IN CONTINGENT LIABILITIES AND CONTINGENT ASSETS

There were no material changes in contingent liabilities or contingent assets since the last statement of financial position as at 30 June 2013.

14. CAPITAL COMMITMENTS

Except for the purchase of plant and machinery for an amount of RM 5 million, there was no material capital commitment as at 30 June 2013.

Extrusion and fabrication

Turnover for quarter under review was RM23.9m which is not much changed from the RM24m recorded in the corresponding quarter in the previous year. However an operating loss of RM0.9m was recorded compared to the operating profits of RM2.7m previously. Lower selling prices due to intense competition and higher production overheads were the main reasons for the poor performance.

Aluminium billet and tolling

This sector recorded an operating profit of RM0.8m on the back of a turnover of RM0.6m compared to an operating loss of RM1m with turnover of RM0.4m previously. The better performance was mainly due to higher inter-company sales. An amount of RM18.4m was recorded compared to RM12.2m, an increase of almost 51%.

Construction contract

This sector recorded a nominal sales of RM11,000 for the current quarter as work has not started for most of the jobs secured. An operating loss of RM0.6m was incurred.

Renewable Energy

A turnover of RM3.4m with operating profit of RM2.3m was recorded for the current quarter. There was no comparison with the previous year as this is a new business ventured into recently.

Others

This was mainly expenses incurred by the holding company and other subsidiaries which were dormant.

Extrusion and fabrication

Compared to the previous quarter, turnover for this sector increased by 32%, RM23.9m for the current quarter and RM18.1m in the previous quarter. In line with the higher turnover operating losses reduced to RM0.9m from RM1.6m, an improvement of 44%.

Aluminium billet and tolling

For the current quarter this sector had external sales of RM0.6m and internal sales of RM18.4m compared to the previous quarter of RM0.7m and RM7.5m respectively. The combined higher turnover enabled this sector to register an operating profit of RM0.8m compared to an operating loss of RM0.3m previously.

Construction contract

As mentioned, this sector did not begin any new contracts in the current quarter.

Renewable Energy

Compared to the negative turnover of RM1.2m (due to accounting adjustment) in the previous quarter, the current quarter registered a big jump in turnover of RM3.4m. In line with the high turnover, an operating profit of RM2.3m was recorded.

17. COMING QUARTER PROSPECTS

Extrusion and fabrication

Sales is steadily increasing for this sector as response from our foreign customers to our products have been encouraging. With the increasing volume and the consequent benefits from the economy of scale, this sector is expected to perform better in the coming quarters.

Aluminium billet and tolling

In line with the higher demand in the extrusion sector, volume in this sector is expected to increase correspondingly. The performance of this sector is expected to continue to be good.

Construction contract

Despite its recent poor performance, this sector has been successful in securing some contracts recently. Work is starting soon with higher revenue to be recorded in the coming quarters. This sector is now able to compete more effectively after having completed a revamp and reorganisation internally.

Renewable Energy

The performance of this sector is expected to continue to be good as its products have been well received. More efforts in promoting and marketing will be carried out to ensure better results.

18. PROFIT FORECAST OR PROFIT GUARANTEE

No profit forecast or profit guarantee has been issued by the Group.

19. RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS
