NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORT

PART B - EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO APPENDIX 9B OF THE MAIN MARKET LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD

B1. PERFORMANCE REVIEW

a) Performance of current quarter against the preceding year's corresponding quarter

The Group posted a revenue of RM21.90 million , representing increase of 13% against the corresponding preceding year quarter's revenue of RM20.52 million. The increase in revenue was due mainly to the added contribution from the new leather product line which was acquired by the retailing division in July 2012 .

However the Group registered a loss before taxation of RM0.11 million as compared to the preceding year corresponding quarter's profit before taxation of RM0.93 million. This decline was mainly due to the share loss from an associate and the increase in operating expenses at group level for this particular quarter.

b) Performance of current 6 months' period against the preceding year's corresponding period

For the 6 months' financial period ended 30 September 2012, the Group registered a revenue of RM41.32million, 11% higher than the same period last year. The improvement was mainly attributed to the new adoption of retailing's marketing strategy and new leather products brand .

The Group achieved a higher profit before tax of RM11.72 million in this current period against the preceding year's corresponding period of RM1.68 million. This significant increase was due to the gain on disposal of a subsidiary.

Subsequent to the disposal of the subsidiaries in the engineering division, the Group's engineering and construction segment is remain dormant.

B2. COMPARISON WITH IMMEDIATE PRECEEDING QUARTER'S RESULTS

The Group recorded a loss before taxation of RM0.11 million for the current quarter, as compared to the profit before taxation of RM11.82 million for the immediate preceding quarter. A higher profit before taxation for the immediate preceding quarter was due to the gain on disposal of a subsidiary as earlier mentioned. The loss for this period is explained as in B1 (a) above.

B3. COMMENTARY ON PROSPECTS

The Board will continue to focus on its business of leather goods trading and remains optimistic on the prospects of the Group.

The Board is of the view that the cash proceeds arising from the disposal of a subsidiary has provided an opportunity to support the expansion of the Group's trading activities in the retail division as well as to finance the acquisition, and investment into synergistic and new viable ventures for the Group.
