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### Explanatory Notes Pursuant to Financial Reporting Standard ("FRS") No. 134

#### A1. BASIS OF PREPARATION

The interim financial statements of Superlon Holdings Berhad ("Superlon" or "the Company") are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") 134: Interim Financial Reporting issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standard Board and paragraph 9.22 and Part A of Appendix 9B of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 30 April 2017. The explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 30 April 2017.

#### A2. CHANGES IN ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### A8. DIVIDEND PAID

On 14 Dec 2017, the Board of Directors has declared and approved the second interim single-tier dividend of 1 sen per ordinary share (FY 2017 Second Interim : 1.25 sen after adjusting for the 2-for-1 share split) for the financial year ending 30 April 2018. The second interim single-tier dividend was paid on 25 January 2018 to shareholders whose name appeared on the company's Record of Depositors on 4 January 2018.

#### B. Additional Information Required By Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad Listing Requirements

# **B1. PERFORMANCE REVIEW**

The Group revenue for the current quarter of RM27.1 million increased by RM1.3 million as compared to the same quarter of previous year.

The Group registered a profit before tax of RM5.0 million in the current quarter as compared to RM8.0 million during the same quarter of previous year

The manufacturing division recorded revenue and profit before tax of RM23.5 million (FY 2017 : RM23.1 million) and RM5.6 million (FY 2017 : RM8.0 million) respectively. The profit before tax is lower mainly due to decrease in total gross profit contributed as a result of higher cost of material, unfavourable exchange rates and exchange loss incurred as compared with exchange gain incurred for the same quarter in the previous year.

Revenue for the trading division of RM3.7 million (FY 2017 : RM2.7 million) was higher by RM1 million due to the increased sales of copper pipes to local customers. The trading division profit before tax in current quarter has increased to RM0.2 million compared to RM0.08 million during the same quarter of previous year.

#### **B2.** VARIATION OF RESULTS AGAINST PRECEDING QUARTER

Revenue for the current quarter has decreased by 13% to RM27.1 million as compared to RM30.6 million in the preceding quarter due to less favourable exchange rates. The sales volume and pattern normalised in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter after the preceding quarter experienced a surge in sales volume. Despite the lower revenue, the group registered a profit before tax of RM5.0 million in the current quarter as compared to RM4.9 million in the preceding quarter. Profit after tax of the Group has increased by RM0.1 million to RM3.7 million as compared to the preceding quarter.

#### **B3.** COMMENTARY ON PROSPECTS

Barring any unforeseen circumstances and based on the present trend of demand, the Board expects the Group to achieve satisfactory results for the financial year ending 30 April 2018. Construction of our factory in Vietnam is currently in progress and on track.

# **B4. VARIANCES FROM ACTUAL AND FORECAST PROFIT**

The Company did not issue any profit forecast for the year.
