Part A - Explanatory Notes Pursuant to FRS 134

1. Basis of Preparation

With the adoption of the revised FRS 101, the components of the financial statements presented will consist of statement of financial position, statement of comprehensive income, statement of changes in equity, statement of cash flow and notes to the financial statements. The Group has adopted to present the comprehensive income in a single statement of comprehensive income.

Amendment to FRS 117: Leases

Prior to the adoption of the Amendment to FRS 117, leasehold lands were treated as operating leases. The considerations paid were classified and presented as prepaid lease payments in the statement of financial position. With the adoption of the Amendment to FRS 117, the Group has reassessed and determined that all leasehold land of the Group which is in substance financial leases and has reclassified the leasehold land to property, plant and equipment. The change in accounting policy has been made retrospectively in accordance with the transitional provisions of the amendment. The reclassification has no effect to the profit or loss of the current financial period ended 30 June 2010 or the comparative prior financial period. The Group registered revenue of RM10.8 million for the 3 months ended 30 June 2010, an increase of 25% as compared to the preceding year same quarter. The increase was mainly due to higher contribution from both local and oversea customers.

The Group registered a lower PBT for the 3 months ended 30 June 2010 compared to the preceding year same quarter. This is due to loss in foreign exchange arising from the strengthening of the Ringgit against the USD from 3.50 at 30 June 2009 to 3.20 as at 30 June 2010.

2. Variation of results against preceding quarter

The Group revenue increased by 22.2% during the current quarter as compared to the immediate preceding quarter was due to the recovering global economy which has resulted in increase in demand from customers. The increase in revenue has resulted in the Group recording a higher PBT of RM0.52 million as compared to RM0.41 million in the immediate preceding quarter, an increase of RM0.16 million or 29.0%.

3. Prospects

The Group expects the business environment to improve further and barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Group is expected to sustain its profitability for the financial year under review.

4. Profit forecast and profit guarantee

The Company did not issue any profit forecast or profit guarantee in this quarter and financial year to date.
