A. EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO MFRS 134

A1. Basis of Preparation

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (MFRS+) 134, *Interim Financial Reporting* and paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad. They do not include all of the information required for full annual financial statements, and should be read in conjunction with the consolidated financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2013.

The accounting policies and methods of computation adopted by the Group in this interim financial statement are consistent with those adopted in the financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2013. The explanatory notes attached to the Interim Financial Statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant for an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 31 December 2013.

B. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THE LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD

B1. Review of Performance

(a) Current Quarter against Previous Year Corresponding Quarter

Revenue

Group revenue for the fourth quarter ended 31 December 2014 approximate the preceding year corresponding quarter, decrease by 1.9% or RM1.7 million to RM86.8 million from RM88.5 million.

Profit before tax

Profit before tax of RM1.5 million for the fourth quarter ended 31 December 2014 was lower by RM1.5 million or 49.9% as compared to the preceding year corresponding quarter of RM3.0 million.

The aforesaid results were due to retrenchment cost and one-off sales rebate of RM4.8 million.

(b) Current Year-to-date against Previous Year-to-date

Groups revenue for the twelve months ended 31 December 2014 of RM353.7 million was RM26.7 million or 7.0% lower than the previous corresponding period of RM380.3 million due to lower demand in sales.

Profit before tax for the twelve months ended 31 December 2014 decreased by RM18.2 million or 44.2% to RM23.0 million as compared to the previous corresponding period of RM41.1 million. Of the RM18.2 million variance, a total of RM6.8 million represented retrenchment cost and one-off sales rebate.

B2. Variation of Results against Preceding Quarter

For the current quarter under review, the Groups revenue decreased from RM89.4 million to RM86.8 million or 2.9% as compared to the preceding quarter.

Profit before tax was at RM1.5 million as compared to RM6.1 million for the preceding quarter, a decreased of RM4.6 million or 75.4%.

The lower profits for the current quarter as compared to the preceding quarter were due to lower revenue, one-off sales rebate and retrenchment expenses.

B3. Current Year Prospects

The Directors are of the opinion that the outlook for 2015 remains challenging as demand is not expected to have any significant increase. However, the Group sees opportunities for volume

consolidation to minimise cost and growth potential in a new geographical segment. The Group would continue to actively pursue new market opportunities.
