## NOTES TO THE CONDENSED CONSOLIDATED INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE FIRST QUARTER AND YEAR-TO-DATE ENDED 31 MARCH 2012

### Part A - Explanatory Notes Pursuant to FRS 134

### 1. Basis of Preparation

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention except for the investment properties which are stated at fair value, in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") 140.

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of FRS 134: Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2011. These explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 31 December 2011.

#### 2. Accounting Policies

The accounting policies and methods of computation adopted in this interim financial report are consistent with those adopted in the financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2011 except for the adoption of new FRSs, amendments and IC interpretations that are mandatory for the Group for the financial year beginning 1 January 2012. The adoption of these FRSs, amendments and interpretations do not have a material impact on the interim financial information of the Group.

### 3. Auditors' Report on Preceding Annual Financial Statements

The auditors' report on the financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2011 was not subjected to any qualification.

## Part B – Explanatory Notes Pursuant to Appendix 9B of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad

#### 16. Performance Review

For the current quarter ended 31 March 2012, the Group recorded revenue of RM22.64 million. This represents a decrease of RM32.28 million or 59% as compared to the corresponding quarter ended 31 March 2011. The reduction in revenue was mainly due to the operating conditions that the Energy Sector was managing in to mitigate the increase in cost and loss on Energy Payment. This resulted in a lower revenue but an improvement of Gross profit Margin (GP%) by 25%. The reduction in revenue was mitigated by the increase in revenue by the Food and Beverage, Tourism and Manufacturing Sector.

Despite the reduction in revenue, the Group recorded a Profit Before Tax ("PBT") of RM0.42 million as compared to a PBT of RM0.24 million recorded in the corresponding quarter. This was mainly due to the gain on fair value, effects of new accounting standards and reduction in financial expenses.

### 17. Comment on Material Change in Profit Before Taxation ("PBT")

The Group recorded a PBT of RM0.42 million compared to the PBT of RM 21.30 million registered in the preceding quarter ended 31 December 2011. The negative variance was mainly due to the absence of deferred income recognised due to IC Interpretation 4 and the absence on gain of disposal of a subsidiary.

### 18. Commentary on Prospects

The Group is in the midst of negotiating with the relevant authorities to ensure favourable operational conditions are met to ensure profitability of the Group. Despite the efforts that are being undertaken, the Group expects the remaining period to be a challenging one amidst the uncertainties of the global economic climate.

#### 19. Profit Forecast or Profit Guarantee

The Group did not issue any profit forecast or profit guarantee in the current guarter under review.

### 26. Changes in Material Litigations

As at the reporting date, there were no changes in material litigations, except for the following pending material litigations since the last annual balance sheet date of 31 December 2011:

i) A suit by Eden Inc. Berhad ("EDEN") against Sriwani Duty Free Centre (Langkawi) Sdn. Bhd. ("SDFC") as the First Defendant, Dato' Chuan Hooi Huat (who is the former director of EDEN and Sriwani Holdings Berhad ("SHB") as the Second Defendant and Mr. Terry Wong Soo Teng, (who is the former Director of EDEN and the present director of SHB) as the Third Defendant, for Tort of Conspiracy in respect of a lease agreement entered into between EDEN and SDFC on 20 August 2002 ("Lease Agreement") for RM52,657,920.00

Resulting from a dispute in relation to the rental value of a premise measuring 27,465 square feet at Underwater World Langkawi ("Premises"), EDEN had filed a suit against SDFC now known as DFZ Duty Free (Langkawi) Sdn Bhd ("DFZ") has vide Alor Setar High Court Suit No 22-15-2004 to; amongst others, obtain vacant possession of the said Premises, A Consent Judgment was recorded by the parties on 23 November 2010 ("Consent Judgment"), whereby both Parties had agreed that the average rental value of the Premises be determined by Messrs CH Williams Talhar & Wong (for the Company) and Messrs Jones Lang & Wooton (for DFZ) ("Valuation").

Subsequent to the above, DFZ had on 24 May 2012 filed an application to declare the above Valuation and more specifically the valuation by CH Williams Talhar & Wong be declared null and void.

Pending a full hearing of the matter, it was agreed by the parties that DFZ shall pay on a without prejudice basis, rental at the rate of RM1.60 per square foot on the area now occupied by them and shall be back dated to 1 January 2011 and shall continue to be paid until the disposal of the suit. The parties further agreed that DFZ shall deposit a sum of RM2,000,000.00 with the Company's solicitors (Messrs Rajindar Singh Veriah & Co.); as stakeholders, which shall be placed in an interest bearing account. This amount shall be paid out to the Company upon the determination of the rental payable upon the disposal of the suit.

The High Court had on 22 April 2012, 13 May 2012 and 20 May 2012 heard witnesses from both DFZ and the Company. However, the matter was further adjourned to 1 July 2012 to enable the Company's solicitors to further cross examine the Company's witnesses.

- Two (2) former employees of the Company have initiated a claim for constructive dismissal against the Company.
  - (a) Subsequent to the dismissal of his claim by the Industrial Court, Goh Hoe Kong's ("Appellant") application for judicial review was further dismissed by the High Court on 25 February 2010. The Appellant subsequently filed an appeal on this matter in the Court of Appeal. The Court of Appeal had on 27<sup>th</sup> March 2012 dismissed the Plaintiff's appeal with costs of RM10,000.00 awarded to the Company. The Plaintiff's deposit of RM500.00 is also to be paid towards the Company's account of cost.
  - (b) Having had his earlier claim for compensation amounting to RM1,284,118.82 dismissed by the Industrial Court, Thum Soon Yin's ("TSY") application for judicial review was dismissed by the High Court on 17 December 2010. TSY Subsequently filed a Notice of Appeal on 14 January 2011 against the High Court's decision and the Court of Appeal has fixed the matter for hearing on 25<sup>th</sup> May 2012.
