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A. Notes to the Interim Financial Statements

A1. Basis of Preparation

These interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of FRS 134: Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("BMSB").

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2016. The explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2016.

A2. Significant Accounting Policies

2.1 Changes in Accounting Policies

The significant accounting policies and presentation adopted by the Group in these interim financial statements are consistent with those of the Group's consolidated audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2016 except as follows:

On 1 January 2017, the Group adopted the following applicable amended FRSs mandatory for annual financial periods beginning on or after 1 January 2017.

FRS 107: Disclosures Initiatives (Amendments to FRS 107)

FRS 112: Recognition of Deferred Tax for Unrealised Losses (Amendments to FRS 112)
Annual Improvements to FRSs 2014 - 2016 Cycle (Amendments to FRS 12: Disclosure of Interests in Other Entities)

Adoption of the above standards did not have any effect on the financial performance or position of the Group.

2.2 Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (MFRS)

On 19 November 2011, the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") issued a new MASB approved accounting framework, the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") Framework.

The MFRS Framework is to be applied by all Entities Other Than Private Entities for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2012, with the exception of entities that are within the scope of MFRS 141 Agriculture ("MFRS 141") and IC Interpretation 15 Agreements for Construction of Real Estate ("IC 15"), including its parent, significant investor and venturer (herein called "Transitioning Entities").

Transitioning Entities will be allowed to defer adoption of the new MFRS Framework for one year. On 30 June 2012, MASB has given an option to Transitioning Entities to defer the adoption of the MFRS Framework for another year.

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A2. Significant Accounting Policies (cont'd.)

2.2 Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (MFRS) (cont'd.)

In light of the development and the revisions of the project timelines by the IASB, MASB has decided to extend the transitional period for another year, ie. the adoption of the MFRS Framework by all Transitioning Entities will be mandatory with effect from annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2015.

On 2 September 2014, MASB announced that Transitioning Entities shall require to apply the MFRS Framework for annual period beginning on or after 1 January 2017. However, on 8 September 2015, MASB announced that for all Transitioning Entities, the requirement to apply the MFRS Framework are effective for annual period beginning on or after 1 January 2018.

The Company and its subsidiary, DKLS Development Sdn Bhd, fall within the scope definition of Transitioning Entities and have opted to defer adoption of the new MFRS Framework. Accordingly, the Group will be required to prepare financial statements using the MFRS Framework in its first MFRS financial statements for the year ending 31 December 2018.

In presenting its first MFRS financial statements, the Group will be required to restate the comparative financial statements to amounts reflecting the application of MFRS Framework. The majority of the adjustments required on transition will be made, restrospectively, against opening retained profits.

The Group has not completed its assessment of the financial effects of the differences between Financial Reporting Standards and accounting standards under the MFRS Framework. Accordingly, the financial performance and financial position as disclosed in these financial statements for the period ended 31 March 2017 could be different if prepared under the MFRS Framework.

The Group expects to be in a position to fully comply with the requirements of the MFRS Framework for the financial year ending 31 December 2018.

A3. Seasonal or Cyclical Factors

The business operations of the Group were not affected by any significant seasonal or cyclical factors.

A4. Unusual Items Affecting Assets, Liabilities, Equity, Net Income or Cash Flows

There were no items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows that are unusual because of their nature, size or incidence during the current quarter.

B1. Operating Segment Review

Review of Performance for 1Q17 vs 1Q16

The Group recorded a revenue of RM58.23 million for the first quarter ended 31 March 2017 (1Q17), an increase of RM3.39 million (or 6%), as compared to the revenue of RM54.84 million for the previous corresponding quarter ended 31 March 2016 (1Q16). The pre-tax profit for 1Q17 of RM2.55 million decreased by RM1.95 million (or 43%) as compared to pre-tax profit of RM4.50 million for 1Q16. The higher revenue and lower pre-tax profit of the Group can be analysed as below:-

Investment

External revenue of the investment segment is derived mainly from investment properties.

The investment segment has recorded a consistent revenue of RM1.7 million for the current quarter and the previous corresponding quarter.

Despite a consistent revenue, the investment segment registered a marginal pre-tax loss of RM0.44 million as compared to the pre-tax profit of RM1.08 million in the previous corresponding quarter. The pre-tax profit recorded in the previous corresponding quarter was mainly contributed from share of profits in associated companies of RM2.72 million (1Q17: RMNil) which was partially offset by the loss on foreign exchange of RM1.34 million (1Q17: RM0.34 million).

Construction

For the current quarter under review, the construction segment recorded a higher pre-tax profit of RM2.10 million (1Q16: RM1.07 million) on the back of higher revenue of RM35.22 million (1Q16: RM30.84 million).

The construction segment achieved a higher revenue mainly arisen from sale of inventories (represented land received from main contractor as in-kind payment) amounted to RM8.97 million (1Q16 : RMNil) which yielded a higher profit margin as compared to the on-going construction projects.

Manufacturing

Despite the higher revenue achieved for the current quarter of RM13.07 million (1Q16: RM10.35 million), the manufacturing segment has recorded a lower pre-tax profit of RM0.38 million (1Q16: RM1.57 million) as compared to the previous corresponding quarter. The overall margin for manufacturing segment was affected by the price fluctuation in bitumen (the major raw material component of its premix products) which could not be passed on to the customers due to the competitive environment. Also included in the previous corresponding quarter's result was a gain on disposal of property, plant and equipment of RM0.29 million (1Q17: RM0.01 million).

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B. Additional information required by BMSB's Listing Requirements (cont'd.)

B1. Operating Segment Review (cont'd.)

Property Development

The general weak sentiments in the property market which induce a softer demand as buyers continued to adopt a 'wait and see' attitude in anticipation of lower selling prices. This has affected the property development segment to record a lower turnover of RM4.07 million in the current quarter as compared to RM10.40 million in the previous corresponding quarter.

On the back of lower turnover and consistent overhead costs, the property development segment has recorded a pre-tax loss of RM0.46 million in the current quarter as compared to the pre-tax profit of RM0.75 million recorded in the previous corresponding quarter.

Utilities

The revenue of utilities segment is derived from supply of treated water and related services to consumers.

The result of this segment was contributed by a company which became a subsidiary of the Company in 4Q16. The results of this company was accounted for as share of profit from associate in the previous corresponding quarter.

Others

The revenue of others segment in the current quarter mainly derived from trading of construction materials.

This segment recorded a higher pre-tax profit of RM0.09 million as compared to pre-tax profit of RM0.04 million in the previous corresponding quarter despite a lower turnover of RM1.08 million (1Q16: RM1.56 million). The higher profit recorded in the current quarter was mainly due to higher overseas sales achieved which generally yielded higher margin as compared to local sales.

B2. Variance of Results Against Preceding Quarter

The revenue for 1Q17 of RM58.23 million decreased by RM6.31 million (9.8%) as compared to the revenue of RM64.54 million registered in the immediate preceding quarter ("4Q16"). The Group recorded a lower pre-tax profit of RM2.55 million for 1Q17 as compared to the pre-tax profit of RM39.00 million for 4Q16. The exceptional high pre-tax profit in the preceding quarter was mainly due to the substantial gain on remeasurement to fair value of existing shares in an associate of RM14.90 million arisen from acquisition of remaining shares in the associate, a gain on disposal of investment in a subsidiary of RM14.20 million, fair value adjustment on investment properties of RM4.29 million and unrealised gain on foreign exchange of RM3.27 million (1Q17: unrealised loss of RM0.1 million). These impacts were partially offset by the provision of impairment loss on intangible asset of RM7.11 million in 4Q16.

B3. Prospects

Going forward, the directors expect the Group's operating environment to remain challenging and competitive. Barring any unforeseen circumstances and given the intense competition within the construction industry, the directors expect the profit for the Group to be modest.
