NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORT

1. Basis of preparation

The interim financial report is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard ("FRS") 134₂₀₀₄, Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial report should be read in conjunction with the Group's audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 January 2008. These explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 31 January 2008.

13. Capital commitments

There were no material capital commitments for the current quarter under review.

14. Review of performance of the Group

The Group's current quarter revenue was down by RM3.3 million compared to last quarter at RM24.4 million as sales are generally slower in the beginning of the year for construction sector due to rainy season and long festive season break.

The Group's revenue of RM24.5 million for current cumulative quarter was also lower than the revenue of RM27.9 million recorded in the corresponding period of last financial year due to lower revenue generated from timber and PE Pipes division.

15. Comment on material change in loss before taxation ("LBT")

Despite the decrease in revenue, loss before taxation ("LBT") was lower at RM0.4 million compared to RM0.7 million recorded in the preceding quarter due to better profit margin achieved from the existing projects.

However, the Group's LBT for the 3 months' cumulative period was higher at RM0.4 million compared to the corresponding period of last financial year of RM0.1 million mainly due to lower sales coupled with the increase in material cost.



16. Current year prospects

Barring unforeseen circumstances, the management expects the Group to be able to achieve a favourable financial result in the coming financial year.

17. (a) Variance of actual profit from forecast profit

Not applicable as no profit forecast was published.

(b) Shortfall in the profit guarantee

There was no profit guarantee for the current year under review.
