For the quarter under review, the Group achieved a revenue of RM90.160 million, which was 11.7% higher compared to preceding year's corresponding quarter of RM80.742 million. The higher revenue for the current quarter was due to lifting of lockdowns, effecting increase in demand for the Group's products.

The profit before tax for the current quarter of RM5.659 million was 361% higher compared to preceding year corresponding quarter loss before tax of RM2.162 million. The higher profit before tax was mainly due to increase in revenue during the current quarter.
