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Interim Financial Report for the First Quarter ended 31 March 2016

A Notes to the Interim Financial Statements Pursuant to Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") 134

A1. Basis of preparation

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements for the first quarter ended 31 March 2016 are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134: *Interim Financial Reporting* and Paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad. They do not include all of the information required for a full annual financial statements.

The unaudited interim financial report should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2015. The explanatory notes attached to the unaudited interim financial report provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 31 December 2015.

A2. Changes in accounting policies

The significant accounting policies and methods of computation adopted in these interim financial statements are consistent with those adopted in the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2015 except for the adoption of the following accounting standards, amendments and interpretations that have been issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") but are not yet effective and have not been applied by the Group:

A5. Material changes in estimates

There were no changes in nature and amount of changes in estimates of amounts reported in current financial year or changes in estimates of amounts reported in prior financial years that have a material effect in the financial period-to-date.

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A6. Changes in the composition of the Group

On 16 February 2016, Peps-JV (M) Sdn Bhd ("Peps-JV"), a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company, incorporated a joint venture company with Y-tec Corporation ("Y-tec") known as Peps Y-tec (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd ("Peps Y-tec") Peps-JV and Y-tec each subscribed for 6 ordinary shares and 4 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each, representing 60% and 40% equity shareholdings of Peps Y-tec respectively.

There were no other changes in the composition of the Group for the quarter under review.

A7. Seasonality or cyclicality of operations

The business operations of the Group were not materially affected by any seasonal or cyclical factors.

A8. Segmental information

During the current reporting period, the Group operates under one main business segment which is Automotive. The information contains in the Condensed statement of profit or loss and other comprehensive income represent the Automotive segment.

A12. Debt and equity securities

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B. Explanatory Notes Pursuant to Appendix 9B of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad

B1. Review of the performance

Current Quarter

Revenue of the Group for the current quarter was 28.7% lower than the preceding year corresponding quarter due to drop in sales from automotive and consequentially, it registered net loss of RM3.0mil compared to net profit of RM2.5mil in the preceding year corresponding quarter.

B2. Comparison with Immediate Preceding Quarter

The Group revenue was 27.8% lower than the preceding quarter due to drop in sales from automotive. Accordingly, the Group recorded net loss of RM3.0mil for current quarter compared to net profit of RM0.2mil in the immediate preceding quarter.

B3. Prospects for coming financial year

The operating environment continues to be challenging due to weaker demand for motor vehicles. However the Board remains confident that the Group will continue to be competitive in the automotive industry.

B4. Profit forecast or profit guarantee

There were no profit forecast or profit guarantee issued by the Group during the financial year.
