Notes to the Interim Financial Statements - 31 July 2017

Part A - EXPLANATORY NOTES

A1. Basis of preparation

The interim financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention. The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") 134: Interim Financial Reporting and Chapter 9.22, part K of Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities"). The interim financial report is in compliance with IAS 34 Interim Financial Reporting issued by the International Accounting Standards Board.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements which provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group.

A2. Changes in Accounting Policies

Description

The accounting policies adopted are consistent with those of the previous financial year except as follows:

Manufacturing - comprising business units which can be sub-divided into three core expertise areas: Precision Machining, Chasis & Modular Assembly and Hot & Cold Forming. Products manufactured are mainly to cater for the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) markets.

Others - these consist of trading of automotive components for the Replacement Markets (REM) and provision of technical services for companies within the Group

B. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THE BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD'S LISTING REQUIREMENTS

B1. Overall Review of Group's Financial Performance

Quarter 2 FY2018 vs Quarter 2 FY2017

The Group achieved revenue of RM43.1 million for the current quarter, lower than the previous year's corresponding quarter of RM48.8 million, mainly due to lower demand from OEMs. This is in line with the declining trend in Total Industry Production (TIP) by 12% in the second quarter 2017 (April-June 2017) at 117,303 units from 133,372 in the same period last year (April-June 2016), arising from cautious stance taken by OEMs amidst soft market conditions (Source: Malaysian Automotive Association).

Net loss of RM1.1 million was recorded for the current quarter as compared to RM0.9 million net profit in the previous year corresponding quarter, due to lower revenue and higher operating costs, mainly cost of imported materials, as well as labour and production related expenses in preparation for new parts to be launched in the third quarter.

Year-to-Date July 2017 vs Year-to-Date July 2016

For the first half of FY2018, the Group achieved a higher revenue RM98.0 million as compared to RM94.8 million in the same period last year, mainly due to higher revenue achieved in the first quarter of the year following mass production of new parts from an OEM. A net loss of RM0.9 million was recorded for the six months period of FY2018 compared to a net profit of RM0.9 million last year, mainly due to lower revenue from the current quarter and reasons stated above.

B2. Segmental Analysis

Investment Holding

Revenue for the Investment Holding segment declined to RM3.5 million in the current quarter from RM4.7 million in the previous year's corresponding quarter, mainly due to reduced management fee charged for centralised support services by holding company to its subsidiaries.

For the first half of FY2018, revenue achieved for this segment at RM8.5 million is also lower than the previous year corresponding period at RM9.2 million, due to same reasons mentioned above. Consequently, profit before tax was in line with revenue movements above.

Manufacturing

The manufacturing segment achieved a lower revenue of RM43.3 million in the current quarter as compared to RM49.0 million in the previous year corresponding quarter. However, the segment's revenue for the first half of FY2018 at RM99.1 million was higher than FY2017's first half of RM95.3 million.

Correspondingly, the segment recorded a loss of RM0.5 million in the current quarter compared to profit of RM1.4 million in the previous year's corresponding quarter. For the first half of FY2018, the segment recorded a loss of RM0.7 million compared to a profit before tax of RM1.4 million in the first half of FY2017.

Reasons for movements in revenue and profit for this segment is as explained in the overall group performance (Section B1) as the manufacturing segment is the main contributor to the Group's results.

Total industry volume is projected to grow by 1.7% from 580,124 motor vehicles in 2016 to 590,000 in 2017 (Source: Malaysian Automotive Association). The outlook for the second half of the year will continue to be challenging for the automotive sector. As such, the Group has intensified its efforts to further strengthen operational efficiency.
