1. Basis of preparation

Hence, actual results may differ from these estimates.

1. Review of performance

For the Quarter under review, the Group's revenue of RM16.36 million was 23.22% lower compared to the revenue of RM21.33 million recorded in the preceding year's corresponding quarter. The Group's revenue are mainly derived from its export sales, domestic sales and domestic OEM sales for its gas and electrical home appliances. The reduction in revenue is mainly due to lower domestic sales.

Profit before income tax for the Quarter under review amounted to RM55,000 compared to profit before income tax of RM16,000 in the preceding year's corresponding quarter.

2. Comparison with immediate preceding quarter's results

For the quarter under review, the Group's revenue of RM16.36 million was 14.17% lower than that of the immediate preceding quarter's revenue of RM19.07 million.

The Group recorded a Profit before income tax of RM55,000 for the quarter under review compared to a Loss before income tax of RM3.048 million in the immediate preceding quarter due to discontinued operations and provision made for certain products that were discontinued and after accruing a gain on sale of properties.

3. Commentary on Prospects

The Group is confident that both its export and domestic OEM business will continue to improve and remain profitable despite the current hazy economic outlook. However, the level of profitability will be dependent on forex volatility going forward.

The domestic trading business is not expected to turnaround in the coming quarter as yet as the Group is still in midst of realignment of its product mix and improving the visibility of the Group's "MILUX" brand in the domestic market.
