B1. Review of Performance

During the quarter under review, the Group posted a net revenue of RM 18.04 million, an increase of 40.0% over the preceding year corresponding quarter's revenue of RM 12.88 million. This was due to increases in both export and domestic sales. Export sales increased by 57.9% to RM 6.68 from RM 4.23 million while domestic sales increased 31.5% to RM 11.36 million from RM 8.65 million.

The Group recorded a pre-tax profit of RM 0.09 million and a loss after tax of RM 0.34 million during the quarter under review compared to a pre-tax loss and loss after tax of RM 0.65 million and RM 0.75 million respectively in the preceding year corresponding quarter. Higher sales revenue and other income arising from the gain in foreign exchange during the quarter under review contributed to the turnaround to profit on a pre-taxation basis compared to a loss in the preceding year corresponding quarter.

The Home appliances segment recorded a profit before tax of RM 0.29 million while the Investment Holding and dormant companies segment (classified under "Others" in Note A8) recorded a loss before tax of RM 0.20 million in the current quarter under review. For the preceding year corresponding quarter the Home appliances and Investment Holding and dormant companies segment recorded loss before tax of RM 0.47 million and RM 0.18 million respectively. However, both the segments recorded after tax losses during the quarter under review.

B2. Comparison with immediate preceding quarter's results

For the current quarter under review, the Group posted a profit before tax of RM 0.09 million compared to a loss before tax of RM 2.29 million in the immediate preceding quarter ended 31 December 2014. The profit was due to higher revenue and lower operating expenses during the quarter under review. Loss after tax for the current quarter amounted to RM 0.34 million compared to RM 2.39 million in the immediate preceding quarter.

The Group's revenue for the current quarter at RM 18.04 million was 38.6% higher than that of the immediate preceding quarter's revenue of RM 13.02 million. The higher revenue was due to higher export and domestic sales. Export sales increased to RM 6.68 million from RM 4.46 million (49.8%) while domestic sales increased to RM 11.36 million from RM 8.56 million (32.7%).

B3. Commentary on current year prospect

With the emergence of a new consumer landscape due to lower oil prices and a weaker ringgit and the implementation of goods and service tax (GST), domestic consumption is expected to slow down in the remaining quarters of the year. However, the Group is fairly optimistic for its export market sales and will concentrate on increasing its sales to more emerging markets.

Barring any unforeseen circumstances, with various actions taken and a lower cost structure in place, the Group hopes to see further improvement in its financial performance for the remaining quarters of the current financial year.

The Company has not announced or disclosed any revenue or profit estimate, forecast, projection or internal targets for the Group for the quarter under review.
