B1. Review of Performance of Operating Segments

Business Forms and Data Print Services

The revenue for the third quarter was 0.5% lower as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. For the nine months to date revenue was 6% lower as compared with the corresponding nine months in the preceding year. This decrease was primarily due to lower sales of security printing as well as the continual reduction in the sales of business forms.

The profit before tax for the third quarter was 9% lower than the corresponding period in the preceding year. For the nine months to date profit before tax was 36% lower as compared with the corresponding nine months in the preceding year. The fall in the profit before tax was due to lower revenue.

Commercial Printing

The revenue for the third quarter was 11% lower as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. This was primarily due to the earlier delivery of exercise books in the second quarter. For the nine months to date revenue was 3% lower as compared with the corresponding nine months in the preceding year. This decrease in revenue was a result of the competition as well as the trend in schools to move away from exercise books towards A4 pad and workbooks.

The profit before tax for the third quarter was 32% lower than the corresponding period in the preceding year. The profit before tax for the nine months to date was 28% lower than the corresponding nine months in the preceding year. The weaker performance was due to the lower revenue.

Flexible Packaging

The revenue for the third quarter was 9% lower as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. For the nine months to date revenue was 3% lower as compared with the corresponding nine months in the preceding year. This decrease in revenue was due to slower export sales.

The profit before tax for the third quarter was 82% lower than the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. For the nine months to date profit before tax was 14% lower as compared with the corresponding nine months in the preceding year. The weaker profit was due to the lower revenue as well as exchange rate losses.
