The profit before tax for the first quarter was 23% higher than the corresponding period in the preceding year. The increase in the profit before tax was due to higher margins from the data print services.

Commercial Printing

The revenue for the first quarter was 30% lower as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. This was primarily due to lower sales of exercise books.

The loss before tax for the first quarter was 3% higher than the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. This was primarily due to higher labour costs.

Flexible Packaging

The revenue for the first quarter was 1% higher as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The increase in revenue was due to higher sales of paper based packaging material.

The profit before tax for the first quarter was 4% lower than the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. This decrease was due to higher costs of labour.
