The profit before tax for the second quarter was 49% higher than the corresponding period in the preceding year. The increase in the profit before tax was due to higher margins from the sales of security products.

Commercial Printing

The revenue for the second quarter was 38% lower as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. This was primarily due to lower sales of exercise books.

A loss before tax of RM58,000 was reported in the second quarter as compared with a profit of RM697,000 the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The loss was primarily due to the lower sales.

Flexible Packaging

The revenue for the second quarter was 6% lower as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The decrease in revenue was due to lower exports.

The profit before tax for the second quarter was 65% lower than the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. This decrease was due to lower revenue as well as higher cost of labour.
