# B. Explanatory Notes pursuant to Appendix 9B of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad

#### B1. Review of Performance of Operating Segments

Business Forms and Data Print Services

The revenue for the second quarter of RM5.3 million was 11% higher as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. Higher revenue was primarily due to increase in sales of data print services.

A profit before tax for the second quarter of RM483,000 was reported as compared to a profit before tax of RM249,000 the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The increase in profit before tax was due to both higher revenue and increased margins from data print services.

#### Commercial Printing

The revenue for the second quarter of RM1.7 million was 11% lower as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. This was due to lower sales of exercise books.

The loss before tax for the second quarter of RM0.4 million was 5% lower than the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The lower loss was due to lower utilisation of raw materials resulting from production efficiency.

#### Flexible Packaging

The revenue for the second quarter of RM3.6 million was 4% lower as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The decrease in revenue was due to lower exports.

The loss before tax for the second quarter of RM159,000 was 32% lower than the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The lower loss was due lower exchange rate losses in the current quarter, the corresponding quarter in the preceding year reported exchange rate losses of RM92,000 as compared to a RM2,000 loss in the current quarter.
