# B1. Review of Performance of Operating Segments

Business Forms and Data Print Services

The revenue for the third quarter of RM5.9 million was 15% higher as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. Higher revenue was primarily due to increase in sales of data print services.

A profit before tax for the third quarter of RM357,000 was 13% lower as compared to the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The decrease in profit before tax was due to reduced margins from the computer forms business.

#### Commercial Printing

The revenue for the third quarter of RM5.1 million was 13% lower as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. This was due to lower sales of exercise books.

The profit before tax for the third quarter of RM0.6 million was 42% lower than the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The lower profit was due to lower revenue as well as the higher utilisation of raw materials.

#### Flexible Packaging

The revenue for the third quarter of RM4.4 million was 2% higher as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The increase in revenue was due to higher domestic sales.

A profit before tax for the third quarter of RM242,000 was reported as compared to a loss of RM200,000 the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The stronger performance this quarter was due to lower raw material utilization resulting from higher efficiency.
