# B. Explanatory Notes pursuant to Appendix 9B of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad

### B1. Review of Performance of Operating Segments

Business Forms and Data Print Services

The revenue for the first quarter of RM4.8 million was 6% higher as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. Higher revenue was primarily due to increase in sales of data print services.

A profit before tax for the first quarter of RM394,000 was reported as compared to a profit before tax of RM95,000 the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The increase in profit before tax was due to both the higher revenue and increased margins from data print services.

#### Commercial Printing

The revenue for the first quarter of RM0.45 million was 33% lower as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. This was due to lower sales of exercise books.

The loss before tax for the first quarter of RM0.73 million was 11% lower than the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The lower loss was due to lower administrative, selling and marketing expenses.

#### Flexible Packaging

The revenue for the first quarter of RM4.5 million was 1% higher as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The increase in revenue was due to higher exports.

A profit before tax for the first quarter of RM95,000 was reported as compared to a loss before tax of RM304,000 the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The stronger result was due to lower utilization of raw materials.
