#### B1. Review of Performance of Operating Segments

#### Business Forms and Data Print Services

The revenue for the second quarter of RM5.1 million was 3.6% lower as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The lower revenue was primarily due to a decrease in sales of data print services.

A loss before tax for the second quarter of RM14,000 was reported as compared to a profit before tax of RM388,000 the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The weaker performance was due to both the lower revenue and reduced margins from data print services resulting from higher raw material costs.

#### Commercial Printing

The revenue for the second quarter of RM1.1 million was 4% higher as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. This was due to early delivery of exercise books to customers.

The loss before tax for the second quarter of RM0.38 million was 10% lower than the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The lower loss was due to lower administrative, selling and marketing expenses.

#### Flexible Packaging

The revenue for the second quarter of RM3.9 million was 9% higher as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The increase in revenue was due to higher exports.

A profit before tax for the second quarter of RM50,000 was reported as compared to a loss before tax of RM159,000 the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The stronger result was due to both the higher revenue and the lower fixed overhead expenses.
