# B. Explanatory Notes pursuant to Appendix 9B of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad

#### B1. Review of Performance of Operating Segments

Business Forms and Data Print Services

The revenue for the second quarter of RM4.0 million was 21% lower as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The lower revenue was primarily due to a decrease in sales of both data print services and security printing.

A loss before tax for the second quarter of RM208,000 was reported as compared to a profit before tax of RM380,000 the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The weaker performance was due to both the lower revenue and higher raw material utilisation.

#### Commercial Printing

The revenue for the second quarter of RM1.6 million was 50% higher as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. This was due to higher paper trading sales.

The loss before tax for the second quarter of RM2 million was 84% higher than the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The higher loss was primarily due to retrenchment costs of RM1.2 million which resulted from the closure of the exercise book division.

#### Flexible Packaging

The revenue for the second quarter of RM3.6 million was 3% lower as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The decrease in revenue was due to both lower export sales and lower local domestic sales.

A loss before tax for the second quarter of RM47,000 was reported as compared to a profit before tax of RM50,000 the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The weaker result was due to both higher production labour costs and higher factory overheads.
