Notes to the condensed consolidated interim financial statements for the three months ended 30 June 2017

#### 1. Basis of Preparation

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with Paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad and Malaysia Financial Reporting Standards (MFRS) 134, *Interim Financial Reporting* in Malaysia and also comply with IAS 34, *Interim Financial Reporting* issued by the International Accounting Standards Board.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Company and its subsidiaries ("Group") for the year ended 31 December 2016. The explanatory notes attached to these interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2016.

#### 2. <u>Significant Accounting Policies</u>

The accounting principles and policies adopted in preparing these interim financial statements are consistent with those of the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2016.

#### 3. Auditors' Report

The auditor's report of the preceding annual financial statements is not subject to any qualification.

#### 4. Changes in the Composition of the Group

The Company incorporated CIC Construction Sdn Bhd on 12 April 2017 as a wholly-owned subsidiary of Central Industrial Corporation Berhad. CIC Construction Sdn Bhd subscribed a total of 327,500 new ordinary shares at a total subscription price of RM1.30 million on 25 May 2017 with Proventus Bina Sdn Bhd, a company engaged in construction activities.

#### 5. <u>Seasonal or Cyclical Factors</u>

The Group's performance is not materially affected by any seasonal or cyclical factors.

#### 6. Debts and Equity Securities

There were no issuances, cancellation, repurchases, resale or repayments of debt or equity securities for the current quarter under review except for the following:

On 29 May 2017, the Company issued 2,800,000 new ordinary shares of RM1 per ordinary share via a private placement for a total cash consideration of RM2,800,000.



#### **Profit Forecast or Profit Guarantee**

The Group did not issue any profit forecast or profit guarantee during the current quarter under review.

#### 8. Unquoted Investments and Properties

#### 19. Subsequent Events

There were no subsequent events up to the date of this interim report that have not been reflected in these interim financial statements.

#### 20. Review of Performance

The Group recorded revenue of RM15.415 million and Profit Before Tax of RM0.303 million in the quarter under review as compared to RM14.365 million and Profit Before Tax of RM0.502 million recorded in the corresponding quarter last year. The higher revenue registered by the Group was due to the increase in export sales in the quarter under review for masking tapes. The lower Profit before Tax was due to the higher cost of goods sold and the resulting lower gross profit margins related to export sales.

#### 21. Material Changes in results with immediate preceding quarter

The comparison of the Group's revenue and Profit before tax for the current quarter and preceding quarter are summarised as follows:-

The Group's revenue decreased by 10.6% from RM17.238 million in the immediate preceding quarter to RM15.415 million in the current quarter under review. The lower revenue registered by the Group



was due to the temporary softening market demand due to the product price increase in the current quarter under review.

The Group recorded Profit Before Tax of RM0.303 million in the current quarter compared to Profit Before Tax of RM0.762 million in the preceding quarter. The lower Profit before Tax was due to the overall lower revenue and lower gross profit margins for export sales.

#### 22. <u>Commentary of Prospects</u>

The outlook for the 3rd quarter 2017, remain unchanged from the current quarter under review with soft domestic market overhang conditions.

Revenue growth for domestic segment will continue to be tapes driven from opportunities for automotive grade masking tapes as key dealers impacted by volatile foreign currencies prefer local manufactured tapes instead of imported products.

The export segment forecasts improvements in revenue and gross profit margins via price increases to key export customers. The Company will push ahead with product re-engineering to enter new geographical markets and regain lost market share in its traditional export markets. Its re-engineered products are anticipated to roll out soft launches in the 3rd quarter and will continue to drive optimization of plant assets, resources and lower production unit costs. Export volumes are forecast to further increase from an additional potential global contract.

Though challenging, the 3rd quarter will offer sufficient opportunities for the Company to sustain its positive performance trajectory.
