The Group elects to use the exemptions proposed by the standard on lease contracts for which the lease term ends within 12 months as of the date of initial application, and lease contracts for which the underlying assets are of low value. Provisional accounting of acquisition

The fair value adjustments as of October 31, 2019 and the goodwill are provisional as the Group is currently undertaking a purchase price allocation exercise to determine the identifiable assets and liabilities, and to identify and measure intangible assets. The goodwill on acquisition is now provisionally estimated at RM48,659,000. Any differences arising will be adjusted accordingly on a retrospective basis when the purchase price allocation is finalised.

From the date of acquisition, MPP has contributed approximately RM37,576,000 of revenue and net profit of RM3,116,000 to the Group.

A13 Change of financial year end

On April 29, 2019, the Board approved the change of financial year end of the Company from December 31 to July 31 to coincide with the financial year end of its holding company, Scientex Berhad. Therefore, these unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements is for a period of 3 months from August 1, 2019 to October 31, 2019 being the first quarter of the financial year ending July 31, 2020. For the current financial quarter ended October 31, 2019, the Group achieved another record quarter revenue of RM152.56 million. The results include contribution from the Group's newly acquired subsidiary, MPP, of which the acquisition was completed in early August 2019. The domestic market made up RM84.23 million or 55.21% of group revenue. Exports made up the balance RM68.34 million or 44.79% of group revenue. PBT was recorded at RM14.96 million.

The Group's revenue for the current financial quarter increased 23.8% to RM152.56 million from RM123.28 million in the preceding quarter. Group PBT rose to RM14.96 million as compared to RM819,000 in the preceding quarter.

The improved revenue and PBT for the current financial quarter are partly due to better operational efficiency, favourable product mix as well as contribution from the newly acquired subsidiary, MPP. The Group recognised inventories written down/off and a one-off merger and acquisition related transaction costs amounting to approximately RM6.85 million in the preceding quarter compared to RM795,000 in the current financial quarter.

B3 Current financial year prospects

Daibochi, together with Scientex Group, is well positioned to support the needs of a larger number of brands in Malaysia and internationally. The integration of both upstream and downstream processes enhances capabilities and technical expertise, which strengthens and accelerates our ability to develop new and innovative sustainable packaging solutions that effectively meet the latest requirements of our global customers.

Daibochi, with support from the Scientex Group, has made significant headway in joint research and development of sustainable packaging solutions such as mono-material laminates. These solutions are subject to customers' rigorous trials and quality testings and are expected to be commercialised in the current financial year.

In addition to continued efforts in joint research and development, the Group would also pursue further optimisation in the areas of operational synergy and efficiency through our combined resources, as well as leverage on our enlarged network of suppliers and customers.

Furthermore, the Group's recently completed acquisition of MPP in August 2019, effectively expanded our portfolio to now span a broader range of complementary flexible packaging solutions. The expanded portfolio comes in addition to an enlarged manufacturing footprint and customer base, thereby reinforcing our position to capture more growth opportunities.

Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Group is confident that our ongoing optimisation efforts and the enlarged manufacturing operations will result in strong revenue performance and improved profitability in the current financial year ending July 31, 2020 (FY2020).
