PART A - SELECTED EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARDS (FRSs) 134

(1) Basis of Preparation

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Financial Reporting Standards (FRSs) 134: Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2007. These explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provides an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 March 2007.

(2) Changes in Accounting Policies

The accounting policies and methods of computation adopted by the Group in this interim financial report are consistent with those adopted and disclosed in the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2007.

To date the Company has adopted those new and revised FRSs that are mandatory for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2006 and 1 October 2006, except for the adoption of the following/revised FRS effective for financial period beginning 1 January 2007:

• FRS 6 Exploration for and Evaluation of Mineral Resources

The Board of Directors do not anticipate that the application of these standards when they are effective will have a material impact on the result and financial position of the Group.

The Group has not adopted FRS 139 - Financial Instruments: Recognition and Measurement where its effective date has been deferred to a date to be announced by Malaysian Accounting Standards Board (MASB).

(3) Auditors' Report on Preceding Annual Financial Statements

The auditors' report on the financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2007 was not qualified.

The business operations of the Group's performance were not significantly affected by any seasonal and cyclical factors.

There was no dividend paid for the 3rd quarter ended 31 December 2007.

(10) Debt and Equity Securities

The Group did not undertake any other issuance and/or repayment of debt and equity securities, share cancellations, shares held as treasury and resale of treasury shares for current quarter, except for the issuance of additional shares as detailed below:

As reported in the last quarter, the remaining outstanding balance of Redeemable Convertible Secured Loan stocks ("RCSLS") of RM943,033 was settled by way of its conversion to 943,033 new ordinary shares of the Company, at par value of RM1 each. The new ordinary shares were granted for listing on 25 October 2007.

(11) Changes in the Composition of the Group

There was no change in the composition of the Group during the current quarter except for the deconsolidation of a subsidiary company as detailed below:

On 12 November 2007, the Board of Directors of a wholly owned subsidiary, Denko-HLB Marketing (M) Sdn. Bhd. (DHLBM) had decided to wind-up DHLBM under the provision of Companies Act, 1965, via presenting a petition to the High Court of Malaya, Johor Bahru, Johor. This had caused the Company to loose its rights to govern the financial and operating policies of DHLBM and accordingly DHLBM had been deconsolidated from the Group with effect from 12 November 2007. This has given rise to a gain on deconsolidation of RM478,257 to the group.

(18) Review of Current Quarter Performance

The Group's revenue increased approximately by RM10.785 million or 37.15%, from RM29.029 million in the same quarter in the preceding financial period ended 31 December 2006 to RM39.814 million in this quarter. The increase in revenue is due to increase in production as a result of the introduction of new products for manufacturing in the current and previous quarter.

The Group's performance improved from a pre tax loss of RM188 thousand in the same quarter in the preceding financial year to a pre tax profit of RM4.016 million for the current quarter. The increase in profit is mainly due to improved margins secured on the new products manufactured and higher demand in manufacturing sector.

(19) Comparison with Immediate Preceding Quarter's Results

The Group achieved revenue of RM39.814 million for the quarter under review. This represents a marginal decrease of RM32 thousand in revenue or 0.08 % lower than that of its previous quarter. The group registered a profit before tax of RM4.016 million in the current quarter as compared to the preceding quarter ended 30 September 2007 when it registered a profit before tax of RM3.366 million. The slight increase in profit is due to improved margins and stable demand in the manufacturing sector.

(20) Current Year Prospects

The Group's main contribution would continue to be from the manufacturing segment. The other segments have shown improvements and will be continuously monitored in order to improve their performances. The directors are hopeful that the Group's performance for the rest of the financial period is expected to improve.

(21) Profit Forecast and Profit Guarantee

The profit forecast is not applicable for the current quarter under review.

There are no further developments on the outstanding profit guarantee as reported in the Audited Financial Statements for the year ended 31 March 2007.

Hong Leong Bank Berhad (Hong Leong) vs Denko Industrial Corporation Berhad (DICB) and Four Former Directors of Skiva Holdings Sdn. Bhd. (SHSB)
Kuala Lumpur High Court Suit No.: 5-22-1689-2007

On 11 January 2008, DICB received a writ summon filed in the High Court of Malaya, Kuala Lumpur dated 10 December 2007, for allegedly failing to settle the gross amount of RM6,156,245.99 as at 31 July 2007, owing by a former subsidiary company SHSB which was placed under liquidation on 5 July 2005, whereby DICB and Four Former Directors of SHSB were guarantors of the facilities offered to SHSB.

The management are in the midst of negotiating and discussing with Hong Leong Bank Berhad and the four former directors of SHSB on the propose instalment payment plan.

The net liabilities of RM5,710,435 as of 31 December 2007, after taking into consideration all the properties pledged for the said facilities has been accounted for in the company's book as provision for corporate guarantee, as disclosed in Part A, note 17 of the explanatory notes.
