Part A - Explanatory Notes Pursuant To Financial Reporting Standard 134

1. Accounting Policies

The interim financial report is unaudited and have been prepared in compliance with Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") 134 - Interim Financial Reporting (formerly known as MASB 26) issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB"), and part A of Appendix 9B of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("BMSB").

The Company has given unsecured corporate guarantees totalling RM12.0 million to certain financial institutions for credit facilities granted to certain of its subsidiary companies. Accordingly, the Company is contingently liable to such financial institutions to the extent of the amount of credit facilities utilised. There were no contingent assets as at the date of this report.

16. Review Of Performance

Group revenue increased by 41.1% to RM12.7 million during the current quarter as compared to RM9.0 million achieved in the corresponding quarter in 2007, while Group pretax profit increased by 105.7% to RM2.14 million as compared to RM1.04 million in the corresponding quarter in 2007.

Both the increase in revenue and pretax profit were due to the full inclusion of the results of the new subsidiary, Brilliant Paints Sdn Bhd and also the effects of the upward selling price adjustments in the last two quarters.

17. Comparison With Previous Quarter's Results

Revenue for the current quarter was at RM12.7 million as compared to the previous quarter of RM12.57 million, representing a marginal increase of 1.1%. Pretax profit at RM2.14 million was 20.9% higher as compared to the pretax profit of RM1.77 million in the previous quarter.

The increase in pretax profit was due to the effects of the upward selling price adjustments in the last two quarters.

18. Current Year Prospects

With the full restoration of the production facility and profit contribution from the newly acquired subsidiary, Brilliant Paints Sdn Bhd, the Board expects the Group to achieve a much better performance for the financial year 2008. However, the performance in the last quarter of 2008 is likely to be affected by the sharp contraction and slowdown in the global economy.
