On 19 November 2011, the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board (MASB) issued a new MASB approved accounting framework, the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (MFRS Framework).

The MFRS Framework is to be applied by all Entities Other Than Private Entities for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2012, with the exception of entities that are within the scope of MFRS 141 Agriculture (MFRS 141) and IC Interpretation 15 Agreements for Construction of Real Estate (IC 15), including its parent, significant investor and venturer (herein called 'Transitioning Entities').

Transitioning Entities will be allowed to defer adoption of the new MFRS Framework for an additional one year. Consequently, adoption of the MFRS Framework by Transitioning Entities will be mandatory for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2013.

The Group falls within the scope definition of Transitioning Entities and has opted to defer adoption of the new MFRS Framework. The Group has not completed its assessment of the financial effects of the differences between Financial Reporting Standards and accounting standards under the MFRS Framework. Accordingly, the consolidated financial performance and financial position as disclosed in these interim financial statements for the period ended 31 March 2012 could be different if prepared under the MFRS Framework.

The Group has registered revenue of RM23.4 million and profit before tax RM1.5 million for the six months ended 30 September 2012 as compared to revenue of RM30.5 million and loss before tax of RM1.4 million for the previous corresponding financial period. The Group's profit before tax has increased by more than 100% in the current year as compared to the previous corresponding year period and is mainly attributed to improved margin for properties sold in Saujana O-Lot project.

B2. Explanatory comment on any material change in the profit before taxation for the quarter reported on as compared with the immediate preceding quarter.

The Group's profit before tax of RM539,000 for the second quarter as compared to RM964,000 registered in the immediate preceding quarter ended 31 December 2011 was approximately 44% lower. This is due to a lower revenue recorded from slow sales of Saujana O-Lot.

B3. Current Year Prospect

Kota Masai Project (Mukim Plentong, Johor)

The sales of commercial and residential properties are doing well and we expect the encouraging response to continue.

Saujana O-Lot Project (Mukim Damansara, Selangor)

The financial crisis in Europe and the volatile recovery in the US, coupled with the tightening of lending policy in Malaysia, the purchasers' sentiments of high end properties has been affected. The sales have been slow even though interests are still strong evidenced by frequent walk-in and enquiries at the sales office. The sales are expected to pick up when the lending policy is relaxed and the external conditions improved.
