# NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENTS - FIRST QUARTER ENDED 31 MARCH 2017

#### A1 Basis of Preparation

The interim financial report has been prepared in accordance with MFRS134 Interim Financial Reporting and Paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad and should be read in conjunction with the Group's audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2016 and the accompanying explanatory notes attached to this interim financial report except that the Company has prepared the statements of cash flows using the direct method. The Company decided to continue using the direct method in the preparation of its statements of cash flows.

The explanatory notes attached to the interim financial report provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Company and its subsidiaries ("the Group") since the year ended 31 December 2016.

#### A2 Changes in accounting policies

The significant accounting policies adopted are consistent with those of the audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2016. The new, revised and amended MFRS and IC Interpretations, which are effective for the financial periods beginning on or after 1 January 2017, did not have any material impact on the financial results of the Group.

# Comparison between 1 Qtr 2017 and 1 Qtr 2016

#### **Group Summary**

The Group revenue for the current financial period of RM31.1 million reported an increased by 5% as compared with RM29.7 million recorded in the corresponding period last year. The increased are mainly contributed from port and logistic segment and hotelier segments.

# **Port & Logistics**

The port & logisitics segment become the Group's main source of revenue and profit before tax for the current financial period contributing 88% (31/3/16: 85%) and more than 100% (31/3/16: >100%) respectively.

It revenue comprises mainly of revenue from port operations for the provision of port facilities and ancillary services at Lumut Maritime Terminal (LMT) and contractual revenue under the operation and maintenance of Lekir Bulk Terminal besides the revenue from sales and rental of LMT port related industrial land. For the period under review, the revenue of RM27.5 million (31/3/16: RM25.4 million) increased by 20% mainly as a result of increased cargo throughput of 5% from LMT and 23% from LBT and no land sales recorded (31/3/16: RMNil million). This consequently resulted in an overall increase in profit before tax of 20% amounting to RM13.2 million (31/3/15: RM11.0 million).

#### **Property development**

This segment provided revenue and loss before tax of 0% (31/3/16: 1%) and 0% (31/3/16: LBT 93%) respectively to the Group total revenue and profit before tax for the current financial period under review.

It derives mainly from sales of development land, profits from property development joint ventures and other ancillary services. For the current financial quarter under review, the revenue decreased from RM22.8 million to RM0 million of which 95% contributed by development joint venture project and 5% from ancillary services. The segment loss before tax amounted to RM12.8 million (31/3/16: LBT RM3.2 million).

#### **Hospitality & tourism**

This segment contributed revenue from hotel operation and rental income amounting to RM3.6 million (31/3/16: RM3.6) for the current financial period under review. The segment also contributed a loss before tax of RM0.8 million (31/3/16: LBT RM1.2 million) for the current financial period under review.

## Management services and others

This segment did not contributed to the revenue (31/3/16: RM0.5 million) for the current financial quarter under review. The segment also contributed a loss before tax of RM3.9 million for the current financial period under review as opposed to RM3.2 million same period last year.

## A6 Comments about Seasonal or Cyclical Factors

The Group's operations are not materially affected by any seasonal and cyclical factors. However, there is a compensating effect on its results due to the performance of the various segmental activities of the Group.

(a) The Company had on 28 February 2012 (entered into a conditional Settlement Agreement ("Settlement Agreement") with Perak Equity Sdn Bhd ("PESB") to partially settle the total debt of RM104.62 million owing as at 31 December 2011 by PESB to the Company by way of set-off against the total purchase consideration of RM70.27 million for two (2) properties to be acquired by the Company from PESB ("Proposed Settlement"). #### **B2** Comment on Material Change in Profit Before Taxation

The Group made a loss before taxation (LBT) of RM4.4 million in the current financial quarter ended 31 March 2017 as compared to a profit before taxation of RM15.2 million for the immediate preceding quarter ended 31 December 2016. The decrease in PBT is mainly increase in throughput performance in port & logistics segment and hotelier could not cover costs incurred from other segments due to most of the development at projects are at final stage.

#### **B3** Commentary on Prospects

The Group may be able to achieve satisfactory results for the financial year ending 31 December 2017. The port & logistics segment is expecting growth of its cargo throughput during the year. Business activities at Bandar Meru Raya are expected to increase during the year and the group is embarking on long-term strategies for township development segment which is expected to result in lower land sales in the short and immediate term.

The Group has not provided any profit forecast or profit guarantee in a public document in respect of the current financial period.
