- THIRD QUARTER ENDED 30 SEPT 2017

#### A1 Basis of Preparation

The interim financial report has been prepared in accordance with MFRS134 Interim Financial Reporting and Paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad and should be read in conjunction with the Group's audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2016 and the accompanying explanatory notes attached to this interim financial report except that the Company has prepared the statements of cash flows using the direct method. The Company decided to continue using the direct method in the preparation of its statements of cash flows.

The explanatory notes attached to the interim financial report provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Company and its subsidiaries ("the Group") since the year ended 31 December 2016.

#### A2 Changes in accounting policies

The significant accounting policies adopted are consistent with those of the audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2016. The new, revised and amended MFRS and IC Interpretations, which are effective for the financial periods beginning on or after 1 January 2017, did not have any material impact on the financial results of the Group.

#### A3 Changes in estimates

There were no changes in estimates that have had a material effect in the current financial period results.

## A4 Changes in Composition of the Group

There were no changes in the composition of the Group during the current financial period except for:

- a) On 26 January 2017, a subsidiary of the Company, PCB Leisure Sdn Bhd ("PCBL"), acquired the entire equity interest of Pangkor Village Resort Sdn Bhd ("PVR") for a cash consideration of RM2.00. Upon acquisition, PVR becomes a subsidiary of PCBL.
- b) On 5 June 2017, The Company acquired a 70% equity interest of Rungkup Port Sdn Bhd ("RPSB") for a cash consideration of RM1.00. Upon acquisition, RPSB becomes a subsidiary of PCB.

There has been no material change in total assets and no differences in the basis of segmentation or in the basis of measurement of segment profit or loss as compared to the last financial statements.

## Comparison between 3 Qtr 2017 and 3 Qtr 2016

## **Group Summary**

The Group revenue for the current financial quarter of RM40.3 million reported an increased by 54% as compared with RM26.3 million recorded in the corresponding period last year. The increased are mainly due to some land sales recognised from property development segments.

## **Port & Logistics**

The port & logisitics segment become the Group's main source of revenue and profit before tax for the current financial quarter contributing 63% (30/9/16: 78%) and more than 100% (30/9/16: 100%) respectively.

It revenue comprises mainly of revenue from port operations for the provision of port facilities and ancillary services at Lumut Maritime Terminal (LMT) and contractual revenue under the operation and maintenance of Lekir Bulk Terminal besides the revenue from sales and rental of LMT port related industrial land. For the period under review, the revenue of RM25.3 million (30/9/16: RM20.6 million) increased by 20% mainly as a result of increased cargo throughput of 20% from LMT and 35% from LBT and no land sales recorded.

#### Property development

This segment provided revenue and provided before tax of 11% (30/9/16: 2%) and more than 100% (30/9/16: >100%) respectively to the Group total revenue and profit before tax for the current financial guarter under review.

It derives mainly from sales of development land, profits from property development joint ventures and other ancillary services. For the current financial quarter under review, the revenue increased from RM0.7 million to RM4.5 million of which 95% contributed by development joint venture project and 5% from ancillary services. The segment profit before tax amounted to RM6.4 million (30/9/16: LBT RM6.8 million).

#### Hospitality & tourism

This segment contributed revenue from hotel and rest houses operations, development and operation of themepark and rental income amounting to RM10.5 million (30/9/16:

RM4.2 million) for the current financial quarter under review. The segment also contributed a loss before tax of RM18.9 million (30/9/16: LBT RM1.5 million) for the current financial quarter under review.

#### Management services and others

This segment contributed revenue of RM0.8 million for the previous quarter ended 30 September 2016. The segment contributed a loss before tax of RM10.1 million for the current financial quarter under review as opposed to loss before tax of RM6.2 million same period last year.

## <u>Comparison between 9 months ended 30 September 2017 and 30 September 2016</u> Group Summary

The Group Revenue for the current financial period has increased by 41% of RM122.5 million from RM86.5 million recorded in the corresponding financial period last year. Loss before tax for the current financial period has correspondingly increased by significantly.

## **Port & logistics**

The port & logistics segment become the Group's main source of revenue and profit before tax for the current period by contributing 64% (30/9/16: 80%) and 100% (30/9/16: 100%) of the Group's total revenue and profit before tax respectively.

For the period under review, revenue increased by 13% to RM78.6 million (30/9/16: RM69.8 million) mainly as a result of 17% and 20% increase cargo throughput at LMT and LBT. This consequently resulted in 11% overall increase in profit before tax to RM32.3 million (30/9/16: RM28.9 million).

## **Property development**

This segment provided revenue and profit before tax of 16% (30/9/16: 5%) and >100% (30/6/16: >100%) respectively of the Group's total revenue and profit before tax during the period under review.

For the period under review, the revenue increased to RM20.3 million (30/9/16:RM4.0 million) which was due to recognition of some land sales. The segment profit before tax amounted to RM19.9 million (30/9/16: LBT RM3.5 million).

#### Hospitality & tourism

This segment contributed revenue from hotel and rest house operation, development and operation of themepark and rental income amounting to RM19.3 million (30/9/16: RM12 million) due to higher demand for convention and foods and beverages for the period under review. The segment also contributed a loss before tax of RM50.5 million (30/9/16: LBT RM16.5 million) after inclusion of operating loss of the animation themepark.

#### Management services and others

This segment contributed revenue from dividend income and sale of land RM6.8 million (30/9/16: RM16.8 million) for the period under review. The segment also contributed a loss before tax of RM16.8 million (30/9/2016: PBT RM0.9 million) for the period under review.

## A6 Comments about Seasonal or Cyclical Factors

The Group's operations are not materially affected by any seasonal and cyclical factors. However, there is a compensating effect on its results due to the performance of the various segmental activities of the Group.

The Group made a loss before taxation (LBT) of RM13.5 million in the current financial quarter ended 30 September 2017 as compared to a profit before taxation of RM1.7 million for the immediate preceding quarter ended 30 June 2017. The decrease in PBT is mainly due to the operation of Animation Theme Park Sdn Bhd ("ATP") still unable to cover its operating and administrative expenses during the current financial quarter.

## **B3** Commentary on Prospects

The Group is not expecting to achieve a profitable position for the financial year ending 31 December 2017. This is mainly due to Animation Theme Park Sdn Bhd ("ATP"), which is yet to achieve its breakeven point. However, the port & logistics segment is reporting continued growth in its cargo throughput during the year with its productivity and efficiency improvement program has begun to show some results. The Group is embarking on long-term strategies for its township development segment which is expected to result in lower land sales in the short and immediate term.
