PART B - EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO APPENDIX 9B OF THE LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD

B1 Review of performance

For the financial period ended 30 June 2013, the Group recorded consolidated revenue of RM104.2 million which was RM4.4 million lower than the previous year's corresponding period of RM108.6 million. The decrease was mainly attributable to a lower sales performance from Marine & Industrial segment for the period under review.

Profit after taxation (PAT) for 1QFY14 was RM3.8 million compared to PAT of RM5.2 million for 1QFY13 which included a RM0.9 million other operating income in relation to the write back of allowance for impairment loss on receivables.

Marine & Industrial segment

For the quarter under review, Marine and Industrial segment posted a lower revenue of RM29.8 million on lower sales volume from marine engines and spares.

In tandem with the decrease in revenue, profit before taxation (PBT) for the quarter was RM4.1 million, a decrease of 33.1% compared to 1QFY13.

Building products segment

Building products segment witnessed strengthening revenue with increased sales in the current quarter under review. Year-on-year revenue expanded by 13.3%, from RM36.2 million in 1QFY13 to RM41.0 million in 1QFY14. As a percentage of Group's revenue for 1QFY14, this segment contributed about 39.4%.

Despite higher gross profit achieved on the back of higher revenue and gross profit margin, PBT for the quarter was marginally down by 1.8% or RM0.05 million. PBT decreased q-o-q mainly because of a higher write back of individual allowance for impairment loss on trade receivables in 1QFY13.

Wood Engineering and Supplies Segment

Wood Engineering and Supplies segment recorded a profitable performance in 1QFY14, albeit slightly lower than that in 1QFY13. In view of higher gross profit margin achieved on the back of lower revenue, PBT for the quarter at RM0.9 million was slightly down by RM0.03 million q-o-q.

Electrical & Office Automation Segment

Compared to previous corresponding quarter, revenue of Electrical & Office Automation segment in 1QFY14 decreased by 12.4% and PBT however remained flattish at RM1.0 million, aided mainly by higher contribution margins realized for air conditioners, consumer electronics as well as M& E ancillary products.

Mechanical & Electrical Segment

Although Mechanical & Electrical segment's revenue for the current quarter was 56.3% higher than the preceding year's corresponding quarter, PBT for this segment decreased by 17.8% from RM1.9 million in 1QFY13 to RM1.6 million in 1QFY14. As most projects recognized in the current quarter were at a lower margin, gross profit for 1QFY14 was much lower than that of 1QFY13.

B2 Material changes in profit before tax for the quarter

For the quarter under review, the Group posted a PBT of RM5.0 million on higher revenue of RM104.2 million as compared to PBT of RM4.3 million on revenue of RM100.2 million in the immediate preceding quarter. The increase in PBT was primarily due to overall lower operating costs incurred during the quarter.

B3 Commentary on prospects

The strong economic condition expected locally in the construction and infrastructure industries as well as in the oil and gas and shipbuilding sectors will augur well for our Building Products and Marine and Industrial segments and we expect these segments to continue to show sustainable growth.

And with the continued strength in the local economy, our other three divisions – Wood Engineering & Supplies, Mechanical & Electrical, and Electrical & Office Automation – are expected to register healthy growth and thus cushion us against any unexpected downward trend going forward. Thus, the outlook for the Group is expected to be cautiously optimistic.
