A. NOTES TO INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORT

1. BASIS OF PREPARATION

Despite a decrease in revenue from RM62.39 million for the current year todate to RM52.40 million in the preceding year corresponding period, the Group's profit before tax in the current year todate improved to RM1.89 million as compared to RM0.17 million in the preceding year corresponding period. This was mainly contributed by a better cost control and an improvement in production planning.

16. VARIATION OF CURRENT QUARTER RESULTS AGAINST PRECEDING QUARTER

The profit before taxation in the current quarter of RM606,000 as compared to a profit before taxation of RM532,000 for the immediate preceding quarter was mainly due to savings in production overheads resulted from a better cost control as disclosed in Note 15.

The Group continues to operate in a challenging environment due to uncertainty in the global economy.
