### PART A: EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH 16, FRS134 INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORTING

#### A1. BASIS OF PREPARATION

The unaudited interim financial report has been prepared in accordance with the reporting requirements as set out in the Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") No. 134 – "Interim Financial Reporting" and paragraph 9.22 of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities") Listing Requirements, and should be read in conjunction with the Group's audited statutory financial statements presented in the Annual Report for the financial year ended 31 December 2013.

The accounting policies and method of computation adopted by the Group in this interim financial report are consistent with those adopted for the annual audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2013, except for the adoption of the FRSs, Amendments to FRSs and Interpretations with effect from 1 July 2013 and 1 January 2014.

The adoption of FRSs, Amendments to FRSs and Issues Committee ("IC") Interpretations, which are commencing from 1 July 2013 and 1 January 2014 does not have significant impact to the Group.

The adoption of the abovementioned FRSs and Interpretations upon their effective dates are not expected to have any significant impact to the Group.

On 19 November 2011, the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board (MASB) issued a new MASB approved accounting framework, the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRSs Framework") which are mandatory for annual financial periods beginning on or after 1 January 2012, with the exception of entities that are within the scope of MFRS 141 Agriculture and IC Int. 15 Agreements for Construction of Real Estate, including its parent, significant investor and venturer ("Transitioning Entities").

The Group qualify as Transitioning Entities, which allowed the Group to defer the adoption of the new MFRSs. Consequently, the adoption of MFRSs by Transitioning Entities for the Group will be on or after 1 January 2017.

## A2. AUDIT QUALIFICATION OF PRECEDING ANNUAL FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The auditors' report on the annual audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2013 was not qualified.

### A3. SEASONALITY AND CYCLICALITY FACTORS

The operations of the Group were not materially affected by any seasonal or cyclical factors.

### A4. UNUSUAL ITEMS DUE TO THEIR NATURE, SIZE OR INCIDENCE

There were no unusual items affecting the assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows for the current quarter ended 31 December 2014.

### A5. CHANGES IN ESTIMATES

There were no changes in estimates of amounts reported in prior financial years that have a material effect on the current quarter ended 31 December 2014.

### A6. ISSUANCE OR REPAYMENT OF DEBT AND EQUITY SECURITIES

There were no issuance and repayment of debt securities, share cancellations, and/or resale of treasury shares for the current financial period under review except for:-

- (i) An issuance of 4,230 new ordinary shares of RM1 each, pursuant to the exercise of the Warrants B; and
- (ii) On 12 December 2014, Unitapah Sdn Bhd, a subsidiary company of the Company had been empowered to undertake the issuance of Islamic securities based on the Shariah principles of Murabahah via a Tawarruq arrangement ("Sukuk Murabahah") by way of a one-time issuance of RM510 million in nominal value and in tranches with tenure of up to 19.5 years. The Sukuk Murabahah is rated AA2 which give the Group lower interest rates compared to the previous financing loan.

The proceed from issuance is to refinance existing borrowings of the subsidiary company, repayment of its outstanding balances related to construction works and the balance is utilised for general corporate purposes within Shariah-compliant.

#### A7. DIVIDEND PAID

There were no dividends paid during the current quarter.

### PART B: EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO APPENDIX 9B OF THE LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA SECURITIES

#### **B1.** REVIEW OF PERFORMANCE

For the fourth quarter under review, the Group's revenue decreased from RM58.7 million to RM56.5 million as compared to the corresponding fourth quarter of the preceding year. The loss before tax increased to RM2.8 million as compared to profit before tax of RM21.4 for the corresponding fourth quarter of the preceding year. The decrease in profit after tax was mainly due to increase in Group's administrative expenses and finance cost amounting to RM11.9 million which resulted from issuance of Sukuk Murabahah by one of its subsidiary company to refinance its borrowings purposes in the current financial quarter under review.

The construction division recorded revenue of RM36.6 million and loss before tax of RM40.9 million as compared to the corresponding fourth quarter of the preceding year of RM40.6 million and profit before tax of RM16.1 million respectively. The decreases are mainly due to one off cost incurred for UiTM Tapah project.

The investment division recorded revenue and profit before tax of RM3.9 million and RM25.2 million as compared to the corresponding fourth quarter of the preceding year of RM4.4 million and RM5.6 million respectively. The increased in profit before tax mainly due to changes in fair value of investment properties in the current financial quarter under review.

The property development division's revenue and profit before tax of RM16.0 million and RM12.9 million as compared to the corresponding four quarter of the preceding year of RM13.7 million and loss before tax of RM0.3 million respectively. The increases were mainly due to higher margin recognized on its development projects which were awarded to its related companies within the Group during the financial period under review.

## **B2.** COMPARISON WITH IMMEDIATE PRECEDING QUARTER'S RESULTS (CONT'D)

For the current quarter under review, the Group recorded loss before taxation and profit after taxation of RM2.8 million and RM1.0 million respectively as compared to profit before taxation of RM9.6 million and profit after taxation of RM6.1 million respectively in the immediate preceding quarter. The decrease in profit after tax was mainly due to increase in Group's administrative expenses and finance cost amounting to RM11.9 million which resulted from issuance of Sukuk Murabahah by one of its subsidiary company to refinance its borrowings purposes in the current financial quarter under review.

### B3. CURRENT YEAR PROSPECT

The construction division will continue to bid actively with the opportunities available from the Tenth Malaysia Plan and the infrastructure projects that are planned to be implemented under the Economic Transformation Programme. With the completion of UiTM Tapah concession project and its refinancing exercise, the Group expect better margins moving forward.

The property development division will continue to contribute positively to the Group in year 2015. Our existing developments and other launches in Shah Alam cater to the first time buyer market segment. Our expected launch in the Kuala Lumpur city center area caters to the luxury market segment. Based on the current market trends and strong demands, we expect the responses to our launches to be encouraging.

The volatility of global raw material prices will continue to impact the Group's performance. Despite the global economic uncertainty, the Board is optimistic that the Group will continue to remain profitable for the year 2015.
