The Group's revenue for the current quarter and financial period ended 30 June 2011 increased by 23.0% to RM213.9 million and by 16.5% to RM427.3 million respectively as compared to the same corresponding current quarter and financial period in 2010. The increase was mainly due to higher gross premium underwritten.

The Group's profit before tax for the current quarter and financial period ended 30 June 2011 increased by 16.9% to RM42.0 million and by 8.7% to RM92.1 million respectively as compared to the same corresponding current quarter and financial period in 2010. The increase was mainly due to higher underwriting profit.

For the second quarter ended 30 June 2011, the Group recorded lower profit before tax of RM42.0 million as compared to RM50.1 million in the preceding quarter ended 31 March 2011. The decrease in the profit before tax for the said quarter was mainly due to higher investment income received in the preceding quarter.
