Part A - Explanatory Notes Pursuant to MFRS 134

1 Basis of Preparation

The unaudited interim financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards, MFRS 134: Interim Financial Reporting issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities").

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 March 2024. The explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 31 March 2024.

2 Significant Accounting Policies

The significant accounting policies and methods of computation adopted by the Group in these interim financial statements are consistent with those adopted in the preparation of the financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 31 March 2024.

Part B - Explanatory Notes

15 Review of Performance

Quarter 2, FYE 2025 vs Quarter 2, FYE 2024

For the quarter ended 30 September 2024, the Group reported higher revenue of RM6.23 million as compared with RM4.76 million recorded in the preceding year's corresponding quarter, representing a 30.9% or RM1.47 million increase. The Group registered higher profit before tax of RM2.33 million, increased by 228.2% or RM1.62 million from profit before taxation of RM0.71 million recorded in the preceding year's corresponding quarter. The higher profit before tax was mainly attributable to higher other income received during the current quarter under review.

Distribution and Trading

This segment reported 36.3% higher revenue at RM6.20 million compared to RM4.55 million recorded in the preceding year's corresponding quarter, mainly due to improved performance from all Divisions, namely the Motors Division, Bathroom Products Division, Hand Tools Division and Power Tools Division.

Despite higher revenue generated, this segment recorded a lower profit before tax of RM0.93 million as compared to profit before tax of RM1.03 million reported in the preceding year's corresponding quarter, mainly due to higher reversable of Impairment of Inventories in the preceding year's corresponding quarter.

Others

This segment reported a lower revenue of RM120,000 compared with the RM290,000 reported in the preceding year's corresponding quarter, mainly due to lower rental income generated from the rental of land in Setapak during the current quarter under review, as the land had been disposed in June 2024.

Year-to-date 30 September 2024 vs Year-to-date 30 September 2023

For the 6 months ended 30 September 2024, the Group reported higher revenue of RM11.06 million, compared to RM9.16 million reported in the preceding year period, representing an increase of 20.2% or RM1.85 million. The Group registered a significantly higher profit before tax of RM40.03 million as compared to profit before tax of RM50,000 reported in the preceding year period, attributable to the disposal of a parcel of leasehold industrial land by JKB Development Sdn Bhd ("JKBD"), a wholly owned subsidiary of the Company, for a cash consideration of RM43.08 million. The disposal was completed on 4 June 2024, and the Group realised a net gain of RM37.9 million therefrom.

<u>Distribution and Trading</u>

This segment reported a revenue of RM10.9 million, a 24.7% or RM2.10 million increase from the RM8.74 million reported in the preceding year. Revenue from Motors Division increased 281.3% to RM2.44 million from RM0.64 million due to the better project sales. Revenue from Bathroom Products Division increased to RM3.78 million from RM3.30 million, an increase of 14.5%, due to higher deliveries for project sales and better retail sales. Revenue from Power Tools Division increased by 1.67% from RM600,000 to RM660,000 due to our effective stock clearance strategy. Nevertheless, revenue from Hand Tools Division declined by 5.0% from RM4.19 million to RM3.99 million mainly due to lower market demand.

This segment reported a 17.6% higher profit before tax of RM820,000 as compared to a profit before tax of RM700,000 reported in the preceding year period, mainly due to higher profit before tax reported by the Motors Division and Bathroom Products Division.



15 Review of Performance (Continued)

Others

This segment reported a lower revenue of RM350,000 compared with the RM570,000 reported in the preceding year period, due to lower rental income generated following the disposal of land in Setapak.

Profit before tax of RM15.58 million as compared to loss before tax of RM0.82 million reported in the preceding year was mainly attributable to the gain on disposal of land by JKBD.

16 Current Quarter vs Preceding Quarter Results

The Group reported a higher revenue at RM6.23 million for the current quarter under review, representing an improvement of 28.7% or RM1.39 million as compared to RM4.84 million reported in the immediate preceding quarter, as a result of higher revenue generated by the Hand Tools Division, Motors Division and Bathroom Products Division.

The Group registered a lower profit before tax of RM2.33 million compared to the profit before tax of RM37.70 million in the immediate preceding quarter. The higher profit in the previous quarter was mainly due to gain on disposal of the leasehold land held as Investment Property.

17 Commentary on Prospects

For the medium term, we expect to continue operating in a challenging global economic environment due to the effects from the continuing Middle East conflicts and the prolonged Russia-Ukraine war crisis and global inflation. Whilst, the local retail sector faces increasing challenges from the rising costs of doing business, inflation and supply chain disruptions.

In line with our commitments to continue creating shareholders value and promoting long term sustainable growth for the Group, the Board will be mindful of navigating the business through the current challenging economic conditions. Moving forward, the Board will monitor and continue its efforts in consistently exploring new business opportunities to diversify our revenue stream to improve profitability. Barring unforeseen circumstances, the Board remains cautiously optimistic of the future prospect of the Group.

18 Profit Forecast and Guarantee

The Group has not provided any profit forecast or profit guarantee in any public document.

The effective tax rates for the current financial quarter and period to-date were higher than the statutory rate due to certain non-deductible expenses for income tax purposes and non-recognition of deferred tax asset due to uncertainty of its recoverability.



20 Status of Corporate Proposals

On 5 October 2023, the Company announced that JKBD, a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company, had entered into a sale and purchase agreement ("SPA") for the proposed disposal of a parcel of leasehold industrial land held under Pajakan Mukim 1029, Lot 30487, Jalan Genting Kelang, Mukim of Setapak, District of Kuala Lumpur, Wilayah Persekutuan Kuala Lumpur ("the Land") to Urban Reach Sdn Bhd ("URSB"), a 55% subsidiary of FCW Holdings Berhad ("FCW"), a related party, for a cash consideration of RM43.08 million ("the Proposed Disposal").

The Proposed Disposal was completed on 4 June 2024.
