Profit before taxation of RM2.91 million was 24.89% higher as compared to RM2.33 million in the preceding year corresponding quarter was mainly due to better margin and lower operating expenses.

For the current quarter, the group's revenue decreased by 11.55% to RM37.75 million as compared to RM42.68 million in the previous quarter ended 31 Dec 2015. The company generated a profit before tax of RM2.91 million in this current quarter as compared to a loss before tax of RM6.93 million in the previous quarter. The loss for the previous quarter was mainly due to the fair value loss of RM4.6 million on an investment property at No. 429 – 435 Jalan Tuanku Abdul Rahman due to the current condition of the property which is currently undergoing renovation by the tenant and lower gross profit margin.

The retail sector continues to operate in a very challenging environment and the Group's future prospects remain cautiously optimistic.
