A. EXPLANATORY NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORT - FRS 134

A1 Basis of Preparation

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of FRS 134 Interim Financial Reporting and Chapter 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities").

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the financial statements for the financial period ended 31 December 2009. A10 Valuation of property, plant and equipment

On 22 March 2010, the Company announced that Wangi KMB Berhad. ("WKB"), a 70%-owned subsidiary had on 22 March 2010 entered into a Supplementary Agreement with B.S. Civil Engineering Sdn. Bhd. ("BSCE") to vary certain terms of the Principal Agreement dated 5 January 2007 ("Principal Agreement") in relation to the development of a housing/mixed development on a joint venture basis with BSCE on the land held in Mukim of Batu Berendam, District of Melaka Tengah ("Joint Venture").

The salient terms of the Supplementary Agreement are:-

- a) WKB will receive the proceeds of the Joint Venture over the period of the Joint Venture in accordance with the progress of construction works of BSCE.
- b) WKB's entitlement of maximum proceeds receivable by WKB from the Joint Venture will be RM14 million (Ringgit Malaysia: Fourteen Million Only).
- c) The total WKB's entitlement of RM14 million will be paid by BSCE progressively within 60 months after the commencement of the construction works/project in accordance with the progress of the construction works/project.
- d) Any amount paid by BSCE to WKB in excess of the amount claimable in accordance with the progress of the construction works will be treated as advance to WKB and subject to an additional costs of fund at a rate of 10% per annum monthly rest.
- e) The amount of advance received by WKB will off-set any amount of WKB's entitlement based on progress of the project under the Principal Agreement.
- f) The repayment term of the said additional sum of RM3 million by WKB to BSCE will be extended to 60 months after the commencement of the construction works/project.

The Supplementary Agreement is for the purpose of varying certain terms and conditions of the Principal Agreement and to supplement the Principal Agreement, with the intention to have the terms more comprehensive and clearer for the parties to the Principal Agreement.

A12 The effect of changes in the composition of the Group during the interim year, including business combinations, acquisition or disposal of subsidiaries and long-term investments, restructurings, and discontinuing operations

There were no changes in the composition of the Group during the current quarter and financial period.

A13 Contingent liabilities and contingent assets

As at the date of issue of this quarterly report, there were no contingent liabilities and contingent assets that had arisen since the last annual balance sheet date other than Corporate Guarantee issued by the Company to financial institutions for credit facilities utilised by subsidiaries amounting to RM6.359 million as at 8 April 2010 (the latest practicable date which is not earlier than 7 days from the date of issue of this quarterly report).

By an agreement with the minority shareholder of a subsidiary company, Wangi KMB Bhd, the Company has given a guarantee that arising from the development project undertaken by that subsidiary company, pre-tax profit accruing to the minority shareholder of at least RM10 million will be generated, of which none has crystallised as at 8 April 2010. An amount of RM1 million has been advanced as at balance sheet date and included under Other Receivable in the Balance Sheet.

B. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AS REQUIRED BY BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD LISTING REQUIREMENTS (PART A OF APPENDIX 9B)

B1 Review of performance

For the current 1st quarter and period ended 31 March 2010, the Group recorded a turnover of RM7.538 million as compared to last year same quarter and period of RM3.651 million. The increase in revenue was mainly due to increase in sawn timber sales and construction activities.

The Group's turnover was mainly generated from its timber division involved in timber saw milling, kiln drying and roof truss fabrication. The timber division and construction division contributed 63% and 34% of the total revenue respectively with the remaining 3% was contributed by the property division.

For the current 1st quarter and period ended 31 March 2010, the Group recorded a profit before tax of RM0.448 million as compared to a loss before tax of RM1.776 million for the corresponding quarter and period of previous year.

The increase in profit was mainly due to increase in revenue contributed by the timber division and the construction division, reduction in finance costs as a result of moratorium on interest charges as well as reduction in administrative expenses.

B2 Material change in profit before taxation for the current quarter compared to the immediate preceding quarter

The Group posted a profit before taxation of RM0.448 million for the current quarter under review as compared to a loss before taxation of RM0.65 million in the immediate preceding quarter. The increase in profit was mainly due to increase in revenue contributed by the timber division and the construction division, reduction in finance costs as a result of moratorium on interest charges as well as reduction in administrative expenses.

B3 Prospects

The Group is in the midst of formulating a revised restructuring plan for submission to the relevant authorities for approval. The details of the revised restructuring plan will be announced in due course.

The Group expects a better year ahead since the general economic situation has been improving. In addition, the Group's revised corporate restructuring plan, upon submission and approval, is expected to be able to provide further improvement to the Group's performance.

B4 Variances from profit forecast and profit guarantee

Not applicable to the Group as no profit forecast or profit guarantee was published.

B5 Taxation

No provision for taxation is necessary as the Group and the Company has sufficient tax loss to offset the chargeable income.

B6 Profits/ (losses) on sale of unquoted investments and/or properties

There were no sales of unquoted investments and properties for the current quarter and financial period under review.

B7 Particulars of purchase or disposal of quoted securities

There were no purchases or disposals of quoted securities for the current quarter and financial period.

B8 Status of corporate proposals

The corporate proposal i.e. regularisation plan announced on 26 March 2007 was submitted to Securities Commission ("SC") on 29 March 2007. SC had rejected the Group's regularisation plan and its appeal on 9 August 2007 and 6 November 2007 respectively. Subsequently, the Company applied to the High Court in Shah Alam for a judicial review against the decision of Bursa Securities to de-list the securities of the Company. The application for judicial review was dismissed on 14 September 2009 by the High Court in Shah Alam. The Company had filed a notice of appeal at the Court of Appeal against the decision of High Court in Shah Alam that had dismissed the Company's application for judicial review.

As at 8 April 2010 (the latest practicable date which is not earlier than 7 days from the-date of issue of this quarterly report) the Company, pending the outcome of the appeal, is in the midst of formulating a revised proposal for submission to relevant authorities.

Included in the term loan is an amount of RM42.486 million attributable to the Construction Division of the Company. This term loan is repayable over 5 years with quarterly interest servicing commencing from year 1 and quarterly principal repayment commencing from year 3 after the implementation of the restructuring of the debts in 2005. The Company is currently negotiating with the financial institution on the repayment terms. In previous years, the Company applied to this financial institution concerned for partial waiver of the term loan.

In previous financial year, there was a difference of RM37.867 million between the amount of term loan recorded in the accounting records of RM42.518 million compared to the amount recorded by the financial institution concerned of RM4.651 million via its loan statement. The difference has not been recognised in the accounts since there is no written confirmation has been obtained from the financial institution of any waiver.

In the current quarter under review, there is a difference of RM37.834 million between the amount of term loan recorded in the accounting records of RM42.486 million compared to the amount as confirmed by the financial institution concerned of RM4.651 million via its latest loan statement. The difference has not been recognised in the current quarter since no written confirmation has been obtained from the financial institution of any waiver.

B10 Off balance sheet financial instruments

There were no financial instruments with off balance sheet risk as at 8 April 2010 (the latest practicable date which is not earlier than 7 days from the date of issue of this quarterly report).

B11 Material litigation

There were no material litigations as at 8 April 2010 (the latest practicable date which is not earlier than 7 days from the-date of issue of this quarterly report).

B12 Dividends

The Board of Directors has not recommended any interim dividend for the period ended 31 March 2010.
