Prior to 1<sup>st</sup> July 2006, no compensation expense was recognised in profit or loss for share options granted. With the adoption of FRS 2, the compensation expense relating to share options is recognised in profit or loss over the vesting period of the grants with a corresponding increase in equity.

For the current period under review, the application of FRS 2 has resulted in a charge of approximately RM875,943 to the profit/loss of the Group arising from the ESOS granted to employees of the Group.

#### b) FRS 3: Business Combinations

The adoption of the revised FRS 3 will result in any excess of the Group's interest in the net fair value of acquirees' identifiable assets, liabilities and contingent liabilities over cost of acquisitions (previously referred to as "negative goodwill arising from acquisition"), after reassessment, being recognised immediately in profit/loss.

In accordance with the transitional provisions of FRS 3, the negative goodwill as at 1 July 2006 of RM33,958,168 arising from acquisition which was previously set off against goodwill or recognised as reserves on consolidation by the Group, has been derecognised with a corresponding increase in retained earnings

## c) FRS 101: Presentation of Financial Statements

The adoption of the revised FRS 101 has affected the presentation of minority interests, share of net after-tax results of associates and other disclosures in the consolidated income statement.

In the consolidated balance sheet, minority interests are now presented within total equity. In the consolidated income statement, minority interests are presented as an allocation of the total profit or loss for the period. A similar requirement is also applicable to the statement of changes in equity. FRS 101 also requires disclosure, on the face of the statement of changes in equity, the total income and expenses for the period, showing separately the amounts attributable to the equity holders of the parent and to minority interest.

The current period's presentation of the Group's financial statements is based on the revised requirements of FRS 101, with the comparatives restated to conform with the current period's presentation.

#### **B1.** Review of Performance

The Group recorded a revenue and profit before taxation for the current financial quarter of RM288.0 million and RM60.41 million respectively, representing an increase of 6.8% and 66.0% respectively when compared to the preceding year corresponding quarter ended 31 March 2006. The increases in revenue and profit before tax were substantially attributed to increase in government ceiling price and higher demand for cement in the construction industry and improved operational efficiencies for the period under review.

During the current financial quarter ended 31 March 2007, the Group recorded a revenue of RM288.0 million, representing an increased of 10.0% from RM261.9 million in the preceding quarter.

In tandem with the increase in revenue, the Group's profit before taxation increased from RM48.06 million in the preceding quarter to RM60.41 million representing an increase of 25.7%.

The increases in revenue and profit before tax were substantially attributed to increase of government ceiling price for cement for the period under review.
