Foreign currency trade loan are entered into to protect the Group from exposure to currency movements in exchange rates, whenever deemed necessary and appropriate.

The fair value of the foreign currency trade loan is determined using market rates at the end of the reporting period and changes in the fair value is recognized in profit and loss.

These foreign currency trade loan are entered into with licensed banks at pre-determined exchange rates, thus the Group is not exposed to credit risk or market risk. There are no cash requirements on the date of inception of this foreign currency trade loan.

The group has set aside the cash required to meet the above liabilities when they fall due or in tandem with the settlement of the underlying hedged item.

B7 Changes in Material Litigation

There is no pending material litigation as at the date of this interim financial report.

B8 Material changes in the Profit/Loss before taxation for the quarter compared with the preceding quarter

The Group's sales for the current quarter of RM92.068 million were 15.88% lower than the immediate preceding quarter's sales of RM109.452 million. The Earthquake and Tsunami in Japan in March has resulted in reduced sales for both our wire harness and die-cast businesses in April due to a disruption in the Supply Chain.

The profit before taxation for the period or RM10.728 million is RM11.470 or 51.67% lower than the immediate preceding quarter's profit of RM22.198 million.

B9 Review of Performance

The Group's sales for the period ended 30th April 2011 of RM92.068 million are higher by 24.61% compared to the corresponding period last year. The main reason is the inclusion of three month's sales of our new subsidiary, Kenseisha. Our wire harness business has also increased in line with the stronger automotive market in Malaysia during the first three months of 2011 compared to 2010. However, our sales in April have been reduced due to the Earthquake and Tsunami in Japan.

The Net Profit after Taxation for the current quarter of RM7.797 million is a decrease of RM4.933 million (38.75%) compared to the corresponding quarter last year. This year's results included an operating loss of approximately RM2 million in Kenseisha's business and our wire harness business had a lower profit of about RM1.3 million due to the reduced sales in April. Furthermore, last year's results included a fair value gain of about RM1.9 million on our investment in quoted securities whereas this current quarter's results include a fair value loss of about RM300,000.

The Group's Basic Earnings per share for the current quarter is 3.73 sen compared to 6.72 sen for the corresponding quarter last year.

B10 Current year's prospects

The Malaysian Automotive Association (MAA) has forecasted the total industry sales volume (TIV) for 2011 to be about 618,000 vehicles, which is an increase of 13,000 units (2.1%) from the TIV for 2010. However, due to the Earthquake and Tsunami in Japan in March and the subsequent disruption in supplies of automotive components to the Global automotive production bases, there has been a major reduction in car production output from the second half of April. This disruption was at its worst in May and the situation has been improving since then. The Supply Chain is expected to return to normal by about September. Our customers have also informed us that they intend to recover the lost production in the last quarter of 2011.

The Group remains confident that with our continuing quality and productivity improvement and cost control activities, we will be able to maintain positive financial results for the current year.

After the acquisition of Kenseisha, we have recapitalized and restructured the company and have taken measures to improve its operational performance. Kenseisha had turned around into just above break-even operating level in January and February 2011. However, the Earthquake and Tsunami in Japan has materially affected the business model of Kenseisha operations which require a major reassessment of its business plan moving forward.
